INCURSION prompted outside of the leader and from the three path, vied around the turn, brushed while forging an advantage in upper stretch and drove clear. REDEPOSIT led in the two path as an outer rival applied pressure into the turn, vied with that one around the bend, brushed while getting headed in upper stretch, proved no match in the final furlong and managed place while hanging on his left lead. LEAN MUSIC MACHINE leaned outwardly and brushed a foe at the start, then was jostled between rivals and squeezed back shortly after, trailed in the three path, fanned out to the six path into the lane, bumped with a troubled inner rival in upper stretch and rallied to reach show at the wire. BEECHMONT had his head turned when the gates sprung and broke slow, stalked the top pair from the four path, proved no match for them entering the lane, shifted in, sustained chase in the final furlong but got nailed by an outer rival for show. COCKTAILS N DREAMS laid close up along the inside, chased into the turn, gave way turning for home and yielded on his left lead. FRANKLIN WILDER jostled with an outer rival displacing his own hind quarters soon after the start, raced off of the pace along the inside, shifted out to the four path into the lane, but leaned outwardly and into an outer foe's path in upper stretch then made little impact. SUPER SNOOP was brushed by an inner foe leaving the gate, then jostled with that foe while displacing his own hind quarters soon after the start, pursued off of the pace two wide, shifted out to the five path entering the lane, but shied from an inner foe, bumped an outer rival, and steadied between horses in upper stretch and was outrun thereafter.

STORM THE STREETS stalked along the inside, tipped to take aim outside of the top pair entering upper stretch, pursued while being kept at bay through midstretch, but progressed to bid passing the sixteenth pole and edged past late. GRAYDARIA prompted outside of the leader into the turn, bid and vied turning for home, forged an advantage entering the lane, held sway through midstretch as an outer rival gave chase, but was collared by that bidder at the sixteenth pole and was bested late. GOLD SEARCH set the pace inside of a prompting foe, vied with that one turning for home, got headed entering the lane, yielded through the final furlong and held show late. COLORADO CRUISER got antsy in the starting gate, then broke slowly, tracked in the three path, came under strong urging while chasing around the turn, yielded floating to the four path into the lane, yet kept on to mildly threaten show again late. QUEBRANCHITO tossed his head upon leaving the gate, trailed in the two path and improved without menacing. ANDY'S CANDY raced off of the pace in the four to three path and made little impact.

DUKE OF SUGGINS was hustled out of the gate, tracked forwardly along the inside, shifted out to the four path in upper stretch, rallied to reel in the leaders nearing the sixteenth pole and lasted from an outer challenger at the wire. SLEEPINGONFREEDOM broke well but yielded position between rivals early on, settled off of the pace in the four path, moved to the five path into upper stretch, rallied with a good late kick to quickly close in outside of the new leader in the final sixteenth, but ran out of ground. MO' EM DOWN broke a beat slow and steadied out of crowded quarters between horses at the start, trailed in the three path, swung out to the six path into the lane and rallied willingly to reach show at the wire. SHAKE AND RATTLE prompted between the leaders before checking back into the turn, stalked from the inside, shifted to the three path in upper stretch, ran on to bid along with an outer foe in the final furlong but got outkicked and lost show at the wire. GOLD PERL vied three to two wide into the turn, gained an advantage turning for home, drew clear entering the lane, but was caught by an outer pair nearing the sixteenth pole and faded. GEOLE broke a step slow, raced well back in the five path and failed to factor. PUPIL leaned outwardly leaving the gate, vied along the inside, got headed by his outer counterpart turning for home, shied from that one in upper stretch and weakened. MO DODGY chased from midpack in the two path and faded. NONSTOP VINO broke a step slow, saved ground off of the pace and was done early.

SPURGEON broke slowly, lagged behind leaving the chute, narrowed the gap on the rest in the three to four path around the turn, swung out six to seven wide while picking up stride into the lane, rallied widest to circle foes in upper stretch, gained an advantage nearing the furlong grounds and drew clear while being put to hand. BATTER UP broke a step slow, tracked two wide and between horses, tipped four to five wide entering the lane, rallied to bid along with an outer foe approaching midstretch, but got outkicked at the furlong grounds and was second best. LEVITATING laid off of the pace three wide, improved position while chasing from the four path into the turn, fanned five to six wide into the lane, hung on his left lead between horses in upper stretch, changed over in midstretch after getting outkicked, then ran on to vie for show late and held from an inner challenger. MIDNIGHT SURVIVOR bobbled a bit at the start, tracked along the inside, awaited racing room nearing the lane, tipped out to the three path into upper stretch, ran on between rivals in the final furlong and missed show. DR. NIKO tracked in the five to four path before advancing to press the top pair at the half mile pole, vied three deep around the turn, sparred in the four path in upper stretch, but got outkicked by an outer pair reaching midstretch and weakened. STRAIGHTAWAY vied two wide, then

between horses into and around the turn, but faded in upper stretch. POP PAUL vied for the lead along the inside, then with an outer pair around the turn and faded in upper stretch. 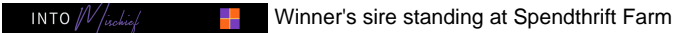

HYPNUS laid off of the pace along the inside, took closer order with nine sixteenths to go, stalked behind the top trio around the far turn, tipped out four wide into upper stretch, ranged up to bid at the furlong grounds, drew clear then held from an outer challenger late. FOUNTAIN LAKE lacked speed in the three to two path, trailed around the far turn, swung out seven wide in upper stretch, rallied well to close in quickly on the clear leader approaching the wire but ran out of ground. STIGLETS stalked outside of the top pair and from the five path, bid in the three path at the three furlong pole, vied three deep turning for home, gain an advantage in upper stretch, but was caught by an outer bidder leaving the furlong grounds then held show. HEDGE broke inwardly yet was corrected quickly with a right rein, pressed the leader from the three path, vied in the two path and between horses around the far turn, battled into the lane but gave way at the furlong grounds. CURVINO was away awkwardly while off slow, saved ground near the rear, brushed with an outer foe turning for home, ran on to bid for fourth two wide and between horses in midstretch but flattened out. PIN UP BETTY bumped with an outer rival at the start, pursued from midpack three deep, tracked from the four path around the far turn, floated five wide into upper stretch, rallied to bid at the furlong grounds, gained command a sixteenth from home and drove clear. CHARLENE'S DREAM bumped with an inner foe leaving the gate, showed the way in the two path before tucking to the inside, remained in hand as an outer rival applied pressure turning for home, shook free in upper stretch, shifted out to the two to three path while bracing for an outer challenge in midstretch, but was bested by that one at the sixteenth pole. KALAHARI DREAMS stalked four wide, progressed two wide passing the five furlong pole, bid and vied outside of the leader around the turn, dueled and wrestled a narrow advantage in upper stretch and held firm from his inner persistent counterpart. PRIVMAN broke outwardly, showed the way down the backstretch, vied with an outer bidder around the turn, dueled while getting headed in upper stretch, yet fought on doggedly through the final furlong. SHALLUS laid off of the pace along the inside, took the turn in the two to three path before swinging out to the five path into the lane, gained show in upper stretch and ran on willingly. FLY GUY MICK hesitated at the start, lacked speed in the three path, shifted out to the five path in midstretch and moved up while hanging on his left lead. LIFES REWARD tracked two wide and between horses, then failed to menace. MIDNITE IN FINLEY tracked along the inside, chased around the turn and gave way. CRYSTAL HILL raced forwardly three wide while under a hard hold among foes into the backstretch, steadied hard with five furlongs to go, recovered to creep closer under urging three deep around the turn, but chased the top pair into the lane and faded. MILYARDER lagged behind around the turn and got outrun. RITUAL raced off of the pace in the three path, but weakened while shifting outwardly nearing the lane.
