DHABAB (IRE) laid off of the pace two wide, split foes five wide in upper stretch, rallied to bid at the sixteenth pole and edged clear. LET MY PEOPLE GO tracked two wide and between horses, pursued in the three path taking aim outside of the top pair in upper stretch, got bumped four wide by an inner foe at the furlong grounds, ran on to bid between rivals at the sixteenth pole, but got outkicked, dueled for place late and prevailed. SCRIPT tracked along the inside, bumped an outer rival while tipping outside of the top pair in midstretch, bid along with an outer pair at the sixteenth pole, got outkicked, vied for place late but missed. TEST FACTOR set the pace along the inside, met an outer challenge entering the lane, dueled with that one into the final furlong, but was surpassed by a trio of outer bidders leaving the sixteenth pole and narrowly clung to fourth. THAT'S RIGHT stalked two wide, bid entering the lane, dueled into the final furlong, but got outkicked by an outer trio at the sixteenth pole, yielded and missed fourth. SURF CITY trailed along the inside, fanned

out to the six path into upper stretch, checked subtly while outside of a troubled foe in midstretch, tipped out from behind rivals shortly after, stayed on but needed more to reach fourth. B D VALESKI pursued from midpack three deep, swung out to the six path into the lane and chased evenly. TODDCHERO tracked three wide, chased in the four path in upper stretch then steadied when put tight quarters among foes at the furlong grounds and gave way. STRONG STATE raced off of the pace in the four path and between horses, rallied in the five path in upper stretch to gain command at the furlong grounds and drove clear. MISS ELLE vied two wide, led turning for home, but got bested by an outer rival in midstretch, then got nailed by another outer foe at the wire to share place. MOM'S CHEESECAKE broke a step slow and brushed with an outer foe at the start, trailed in the four path around teh turn, swung out to the six path into upper stretch and rallied to dead heat for place at the wire. DAISY DUKE was brushed by an inner rival at the start, pursued from midpack near the inside, was blocked behind foes turning for home, remained blocked until tipping out leaving the three sixteenths pole and moved up

between horses. SCYTHIA stalked in the three path, chased in the four path and between foes into upper stretch and gave way. TRUE PASSION raced off of the pace while hung five wide around the turn, fanned to the six path into upper stretch and failed to threaten. MEZCALIFORNIA was off a step slow while brushing with an inner rival, pursued from the three path and between horses, shifted inwardly in midstretch and failed to menace. MASCARA brushed an outer rival and steadied at the start, stalked near the inside and faded. TENTACION leaned inwardly and was off slow, rushed forward to vie for the lead with an outer rival, but faltered in upper stretch and was eased through the final furlong.
