SOLID LEFT was brushed by an outer rival leaving the gate, then put in tight quarters among foes shortly after, pursued from midpack in the two path, progressed turning for home after shifting three wide at the three furlong pole, ranged up to bid outside of the leader entering the lane and drove clear. JR'S GIFT was brushed between horses and steadied back when squeezed between rivals soon after the start, trailed along the inside, saved ground and checked while hesitant to slip inside of a rival at the three furlong pole, got through and rallied entering the lane, tipped out in midstretch then gained place from an inner foe late. FARLEY HALL veered inwardly leaving the gate and brushed an inner rival, vied outside of a foe and in the three path around the first turn, moved forward and crossed over to lead along the inside into the backstretch, built a clear margin from an outer chaser into the far turn, but was collared by an outer bidder entering the lane, proved no match in upper stretch, gave way and lost place late. HIGH ENOUGH broke a step slow whilst last away, laid off of the pace along the inside, chased while moving off of the rail around the far turn and failed to menace. PAVED IN GOLD bumped an outer rival soon after the start, vied for the lead with an outer rival while remaining a path off of the inside around the first turn, ceded the front to his outer counterpart entering the backstretch, pressed two wide and along with an outer foe shortly after, but failed to sustain pressure while coming under urging into the far turn, got outkicked by an outer bidder nearing the lane and faded. WHISKEY OR WINE transferred contact from an outer rival to an inner foe soon after the start, raced off of the pace in the three path. BEER WITH ICE was bumped between rivals soon after the start, then got rank between the top pair and steadied back approaching the first turn, recovered to pursued the top pair from the three path, pressed three deep down the backstretch, but faded with a half mile to go, weakened in the four path around the far turn and was done early.

METATRON'S MUSE laid off of the pace in the three path, paused briefly before splitting foes two wide in upper stretch, bid inside of the new leader at the furlong grounds, sparred with that one through the closing stages and narrowly prevailed. PROVEN HOPE checked back whlie inside of rivals entering the backstretch, tracked the leaders from the two path, moved between horses passing the half mile pole, progressed after getting floated four wide and between horses turning for home, bid in the five path entering the lane, led in upper stretch while hanging on his left lead, changed over as an inner rival threatened at the furlong grounds, dug in and dueled gamely through the late stages but missed. EXECUTIVE ACTION prompted inside of a pair of foes early on, backed off to stalk at the half mile pole, tipped outside of them to gain along with a pair of outer rivals turning for home, bid in the four path and between rivals entering the lane, got outkicked by an foe on either side then chased to prove best of the rest. EMBER dropped back under urging early on, lacked speed along the inside, shifted out to the three path into the lane and moved up between horses. SPYCRAFT vied three to two wide approaching the turn, led as outer rivals issued challenges the lane, got headed in upper stretch and yielded between horses in midstretch. SHOT OF COURAGE tracked three deep, progress five wide and outside of foes turning for home, but chased in the six path into the lane and gave way. KHOZY MY BOY vied for the lead two wide and between horses, then along the inside as an outer rival prompted at the half mile pole, yielded inside of a quartet of foes entering the lane and faltered. SHAKIN LOOSE broke a step slow, raced at the rear in the four path and got outrun.

SAM'S TREASURE tracked three wide, took contact from an inner rival with nine sixteenths to go, sustained stalking pursuit around the turn, chased while lacking progress on the top pair in upper stretch, yet gained into the final furlong, bid leaving the sixteenth pole and edged past. OUR KEEPSAKE prompted two wide, vied around the turn, dueled through midstretch, led into the final sixteenth as an outer foe issued a challenge but got bested. OUTRAGEOUSLY set the pace inside of a prompting foe, vied with that one around the turn, dueled through midstretch but yielded late. SUNDANCE FEATURE backed out from between the leading pair with five furlongs to go, bumped an outer foe while being denied the path outside of the leaders with nine sixteenths to go,, chased behind them and from the two path around the bend, trailed while moving out to the four path in upper stretch and failed to factor.
