LILIES N PARADISE tracked in the three path was roused passing the quarter, angled out ot the five path at the top of the lane, and kicked on to inch ahead of an inner foe in the final strides. PULSTAR vied for the lead in the three path, took command while being coaxed at the top of the stretch, ran on to hold a firm lead into the final furlong, but was edged out by an outer foe in the final strides. A P SWEETHEART raced in midpack in the four path, angled out to the six path passing the eighth pole, and kept on for show. MURIEL SAX bumped with an inner foe at the start, rated along the inside around the turn, angled outside in upper stretch, and rallied late. WHAT'S A GOOD NAME bumped with an outer foe at the start, chased in the two path but finished evenly along the rail down the lane. PRACTICALLY FAMOUS pressed the pace inside early but faded from the two path down the stretch. SPA PROSPECTOR was prompted from up close in the four path but weakened in the stretch. NANZIG dueled for the lead in the two path but yielded three path down the lane. MY RAQUEL hopped at the start, was wellback in the two path and never menaced.

BEBEDOURO raced up close along the inside, took command along the rail passing the three-eighths pole, then kicked away while in the two path approaching the eight pole, and held sway. KIGALI pressed in the four path, lost touch with the winner in the three path passing the quarter, but chased on in the four down the stretch. GOD OF WINE broke out and bumped an outer foe, tracked in the three path, was driven from the rail around the turn, but flattened in the three path down the lane. SHIPMAN bumped on both sides at the start, stalked in the five path but made no closing bid. PURSE THIEF set the pace in the two path, but lost the lead while between foes passing the three-eighths pole, and gave way. MANABI bumped with an inner foe at the start, trailed in the two path early and did not threaten. HEAVY HITTER bumped between foes at the start, raced off the pace in the five path and never menaced.

FOND FAREWELL had a slow start, chased in the two path, was ridden along the inside around the turn, angled out to the five path passing the eighth pole, and rallied past inner foes in the final furlong. MONTEREY BAY stalked in the three path, bid in the four path turning into the stretch, and ran on. TAP ME A SONG set the pace inside, was cued midway around the turn, dug in from the two path down the lane, but was caught by an outer pair in the final sixteenth. SHADOW COAST prompted the pace inside but finished evenly from the three path in the stretch. GLOBAL PROSPERITY raced in midpack along the inside, angled out passing the quarter, swung from the six path into the lane, and mildly gained. RIPPED raced up close in the two path, was driven around the turn, but faded in the four path down the stretch. SHIP SHIP HOORAY raced off the pace in the three path, angled out to the five path turning into the stretch, but made no impact. EDIFICE rated in the three path, swung out to the seven path turning into the lane, but was no factor. WHITE WHALE tracked, was driven in the four path around the turn, floated out to the seven path at the top of the stretch, but weakened. THE RAINBOW FACTOR had a slow start and always trailed.

HEARTBEAT tracked four wide, bid around the turn, forged a narrow advantage from an inner counterpart entering the lane in the five path, sparred as that one persisted through the final furlong, yet edged ahead late. ORDER RESTORED stalked three wide and between horses, bid among foes at the three furlong pole, vied turning for home, got headed by his outer counterpart entering the lane, yet fought on stubbornly thereafter but was bested. MACLEAN'S LULLABY pursued from midpack two to three wide, shifted out to the six path to take aim on the embattled leading pair in upper stretch, but only managed to chase them home to prove best of the rest. TRULY POSSIBLE raced at the rear along the inside, shifted out to the three path around the turn, advanced while swinging six wide into the lane and ran on willingly. DARK THIRTY raced at the rear in the three path, tucked while trailing turning for home and moved up along the rail. SWIFT KELCE lacked speed in the five path around the turn, tipped inwardly entering the late, shifted back out in upper stretch and improved. NYAATA raced off of the pace in the two path, entered the lane in the five path and failed to menace between horses. COTE FLEURIE pursued off of the pace in the three to four path, shifted out to the seven path into the lane and tired. GOTH was brushed by an inner rival leaving the gate, tracked along the inside, but checked behind a foe passing the nine sixteenths pole, chased in the two path into the lane and weakened. COOL LUCKY LADY

brushed an outer rival at the start, raced forwardly along the inside, advanced up a vacated rail to bid along with an outer pair at the three furlong pole, but proved no match for them turning for home and weakened. LADY OF LIGHT set the pace in the two path, but faltered between bidders leaving the three furlong pole, stopped and was eased through the lane.
