TINKI ABARRIO broke a step slow, pursued off of the pace four wide, advanced into the turn to offer a bold challenge four deep turning for home, gained an advantage in upper stretch and drove clear passing the furlong grounds. PRINCESS IS OLIVIA vied two wide, then between horses as a pair of outer rivals joined the fray at the three furlong pole, got outkicked by her widest counterpart in upper stretch and ran on to prove second best. PROTOMAGIC was bumped by an outer foe while breaking a bit flat-footed, tracked along the inside, then from behind the leading quartet and in the two path around the turn, shifted out to the five path while chasing in midstretch and stayed to move up and reach show late. WE'LL DO IT LIVE leaned inwardly and bumped a foe at the start, vied for the lead with an outer rival early on, got headed as a pair of wider rivals challenged at the three furlong pole, chased those ones into the lane, yet kept on while hanging on her left lead to reclaim show at the sixteenth pole, but got caught in the shadow of the wire. MISS JEOPARDY stalked outside of the top pair, bid as an outer rival forced her hand at the three furlong pole, vied among foes turning for home, but failed to keep pace with a rival on either side in upper stretch and yielded. ROCK STAR PARKING trailed along the inside and got outrun.

TEMPTING LADY bumped with an inner foe at the start, tracked in the three path and between horses into the turn, ranged up to bid outside of the top pair entering the lane, quickly drove clear shortly after and held sway. WARM DAYS was bumped between horses and pinched back at the start, trailed early on, launched progress in the five path at the three furlong pole, rallied in the six path into the lane, dueled with an inner rival for place through midstretch and prevailed while closing in on the clear leader belatedly. PEOPLE GET READY laid off of the pace near the inside, progressed tipping out to the three to five path into the lane, sparred for place with an outer rival while inching closer to the clear leader in the final furlong but got bested. HOPE RESTORED was bumped between horses at the start, raced off of the pace in the four to three path, yielded and lost position in the two path with three furlongs to go, yet regained stride moving out to the four path in midstretch and moved up to reach fourth late. CRUISE MISSILE came out, bumped an outer rival and steadied back at the start, stalked along the inside, chased around the turn, then between horses into the final furlong and lacked a bid. CAN I GET AWITNESS broke outwardly, set the pace as an outer rival applied stern pressure, got headed by a wider challenger in upper stretch and faded. ST. ALBANS RAID prompted two wide, vied into the lane, but was outkicked by an outer bidder in upper stretch and weakened. BIG LEAP raced forwardly in the four path, but weakened between horses nearing the three furlong pole and was done early.

I'M MO JOKE pursued three wide, traded bumps with a inner rival while floating to the five path into the lane, rallied with a gradual gain to bid outside of the embattled leading pair in the final sixteenth and edged past. NATIVE RUNNER broke a beat slow, settled well back near the inside, took the far turn in the three path before shifting out to the six path in upper stretch, rallied to bid outside of the new leader in the final sixteenth and got up in time. ANEGADA settled off of the pace along the inside, then two wide with nine

sixteenths to go, crept closer in the two path around the far turn before swinging out to the five path entering the lane, rallied to reel in the leader passing the sixteenth pole, led late but got caught by an outer challenger in the shadow of the wire. MAUI STRONG stalked along the inside, moved two wide and between foes at the half mile pole, ranged up to bid outside of the leader entering the lane, gained an advantage in the process, held sway through midstretch, but was caught by an outer bidder at the sixteenth pole and yielded late. THE WARDEN vied for the lead with an outer rival around the far turn, backed off to stalk with a half mile to go, chased in the two path into the lane but lacked a re-bid. YINZER vied with an inner foe while taking the first turn in the three path, led and crossed over to the inside into the far turn, but got headed by an outer bidder entering the lane and faded. FAST TOWN was tough to load, bumped with an inner rival at the start, stalked three wide, bid two wide entering the lane, but was repelled while drifting outwardly at the three sixteenths pole, lacked a re-rally and yielded place to an outer foe late. ROCKIN HIS SOX OFF pursued from midpack in the three to two path and stayed on mildly. JONATHAN'S SONG balked loading, then hesitated at the start and was off slow, raced at the rear early on, gained in the four path around the turn, fanned out to the six path into the lane before shifting inwardly entering the lane, but flattened out. ICE WOLF was bumped on both sides at the start, trailed in the two to four path and failed to factor. ORANGE DIABLO set the pace inside of the prompting eventual winner, got headed with three furlongs to go and weakened. FANATICAL bumped an outer rival at the start, raced off of the pace near the inside, but weakened turning for home and was transported off of the track in an equine ambulance.

far turn, then drew off when let out into upper stretch and was ridden out under little urging. MULA stalked three to two wide, applied pressure outside of the well-traveling leader around the far turn, proved no match in upper stretch and safely managed place. GLOBAL QUOTE reacted poorly after bumping with an inner rival at the start and was off slow, trailed in the four path, got floated out to the eight path while picking up stride entering the lane and rallied belatedly to reach show late. AMBRIDGE raced off of the pace four to three wide, shifted out to the five path turning for home and ran on mildly. COLONEL CALIENTE stalked two wide and between horses, sustained pursuit from the two path before chasing in the two to three path around the far turn, and kept on one paced. MO MOE MOW pursued from midpack two wide and between horses, then along the inside around the far turn and lacked a bid. ARTICLE bobbed and bumped with an outer foe at the start, steadied in tight quarters between rivals shortly after, raced off of the pace in the three to four path, drifted out to the seven path into the lane and made little impact. AMERICAN LITIGATOR advanced five deep and outside of rivals around the first turn, tracked three wide down the backstretch, but weakened between horses turning for home.
