AJAAYB leaned into an inner foe leaving the gate, then was bumped by an outer rival entering the backstretch, vied three to two wide and between foes, sparred with just an inner rival around the turn, drew clear while drifting out to the four path entering the lane, tucked back to the two path in upper stretch and held sway from a trio of pursuers late. HONEST AL laid off of the pace in the three path, shifted out to the five path into the lane, then rallied to offer a late bid, but only managed to reach place in the shadow of the wire and ran out of ground to reel in the leader. GETTINBY leaned inwardly and brushed a foe leaving the gate, then bumped that rival again entering the backstretch, tracked five to four wide, took aim on the clearing leader from the three path in upper stretch, offered slow progress in the final furlong, vied for place between foes while getting fended off late and missed that position at the wire. ANTHONIAN was brushed by an outer rival at the start, laid off of the pace along the inside, advanced inside of foes turning for home, shifted to the two path to chase along with an outer foe entering the lane, gradually progressed while vying for place with that rival in the final sixteenth, but missed. UNCLE WILLIAM broke a step slow and was floated inwardly at the start, raced at the rear two wide, fanned out to the six path into the lane, rallied willingly outside foes leaving midstretch but leveled off late. BRODY was bumped by an outer rival leaving the gate, chased forwardly near the inside, then between horses leaving the three furlong pole and failed to factor. CHANCE fidgeted just as the gates sprung and broke slow, raced at the rear along and failed to menace. JUSTIFREAK set a pressured pace along the inside, dueled with the eventual winner around the turn, proved no match entering the lane and

weakened. SILVER HALO transferred light contact from an outer foe to an inner rival at the start, took firmer contact from his outer counterpart and was forced to bump an inner foe entering the backstretch, pressed four to three wide, chased around the turn and weakened.

EAST AVENUE showed the way unencumbered in the three to two path, dug in as an outer rival challenged in upper stretch, repelled that foe in the final furlong and held firm from an inner bidder late. BURNHAM SQUARE leaned outwardly and bumped a foe at the start, tucked along the inside while settling into tracking stride around the first turn, sustained rail aim in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, progressed gradually to edge place in the final sixteenth but needed more to reel in the leader. COAL BATTLE took contact from an inner rival leaving the gate, checked when put in tight quarters between the top pair passing the wire for the first time, recovered to stalk the loose leader from the three path, pressed around the far turn before offering a bid in upper stretch, but was fended off through midstretch and yielded place to an inner rival in the final sixteenth. SAFE TRIP HOME brushed with an outer foe at the start, checked in tight quarters among foes into the first turn, raced keenly three deep while off of the pace around that bend, then two wide around the second bend, advanced three wide around the final turn to bid entering the lane, got bumped and herded outwardly by a inner foe in upper stretch, dueled into the final furlong, battled between horses as an outer foe joined the fray nearing the wire and narrowly prevailed. CLYDE'S GOT A GUN tracked along the inside, paused awaiting racing room into the far turn, swung out to the six path while picking up stride entering the lane, rallied in the seven path and between foes into the final furlong, ranged up to bid outside of the top pair in the closing stages but just missed. FREEDOM'S WAY stalked two wide, then between horses before tipping three wide into the backstretch, progressed to bid outside of the leader around the far turn, forged an advantage entering the lane as a wider rival challenged, lugged outwardly and bumped that foe in upper stretch, continued to drifted while dueling into the final furlong, battled gamely as a wider rival bid in the closing stages and was nosed out at the wire. MUTAAWID settled at the rear along the inside, advanced five wide and outside of foes around the far turn, fanned to the eight path into the lane, rallied to take aim outside of the leaders in the final furlong but needed more. AMERICAN HOPE brushed an inner foe at teh start, steadied between rivals entering the first turn, settled well back two wide, gained three to four wide turning for home, took aim from the five path in upper stretch, but flattened out in midstretch. TOUGH LITTLE NUT laid off of the pace along the inside, shifted out four wide turning for home, before fanning to the seven path into the lane and stayed on mildly. BIG TO DO pursued from midpack in the five to three path, then along the inside around the far turn, moved back to the three path turning for home and failed to menace. BRITISH ISLES stalked along the inside, took aim inside of the new leaders while surpassing an inner foe in upper stretch, but lacked a bid and tired. LIPS SAY BLISS lacked speed along the inside and failed to factor. MENA tracked two to three wide and weakened. OSCAR SEASON set the pace along the inside, got headed by an outer bidder entering the lane and faltered. LINCOLN HIGHWAY was brushed between rivals at the start, pulled four wide around the first turn, pressed three to wide around the second turn, but weakened between foes into the final bend and was through early.
