SUTHERLAND tracked along the inside, claimed place from an outer pair while moving out to the three path entering the lane, then gradually closed in on the clear leader to bid in midstretch and drove past in the final furlong. COVERT LAW tracked along the inside, pursued behind the top pair and from the two path in upper stretch, ran on to split those foes entering the final sixteenth and forged an advantage in the shadow of the wire. PINELAND was bumped on both sides at the start, stalked the leader from the two path, bid two wide passing the half mile pole, vied around the far turn, gained an advantage in the three path in upper stretch, dug in between bidders with a sixteenth to go, got bested by his inner challenger and saved place at the wire. DOUBLE NEAT tracked two wide, chased between horses around the far turn, took aim outside of the leaders and from the four path in upper stretch, sustained gradual progress to bid leaving the sixteenth pole but missed place at the wire. TOUR PLAYER bumped with an inner foe at the start, tracked four wide, progressed to loom a danger outside of the top pair turning for home, bid in the four path entering the lane, sparred before gaining an advantage in midstretch and drove clear. DEER DISTRICT stalked along the inside, awaited racing room around the turn, was roused in the two path entering the lane, pursued while moving out to the four path in midstretch and ran on to gain place passing the sixteenth pole. COACH JIMI D brushed with an inner rival leaving the gate, raced forwardly two wide and between horses, steadied while keen among foes with eleven sixteenths to go, pressed two wide into the turn, gained an advantage in the three path as an outer rival issued a challenge entering the lane, sparred with that one through upper stretch, but was bested at the furlong grounds, gave way yet lasted for show. IGNITE THE LIGHT raced off of the pace near the inside, checked behind rivals at the half mile pole, shifted out to the five path and improved position in upper stretch, but flopped back to his left lead in the final furlong, leveled off and needed more for show. CAT ON TIME brushed with an outer rival while off a beat slow, raced at the rear two wide and between horses, came under a hard hold with five furlongs to go, shifted out to the five path into the lane and stayed on mildly while hanging on his left lead. FRIAR LAURENCE tracked three wide and between horses, chased around the turn, pursued in the five to six path in upper stretch and yielded. STRETCH RIDE raced off of the pace hung in the four path, pursued in the six to seven path into the final furlong and failed to factor. LAMBO bumped with an outer rival at the start, sped clear, showed the way in the three path, cut down to the two path into upper stretch and held sway well. MO WORK was bumped by an outer rival and forced to jostle with an inner foe soon after the start, stalked along the inside, took aim on the clear leader from the three path entering upper stretch, but proved no match and held place from an outer challenger at the wire. GOOD MOJO lacked speed three wide, swung out to the six path while picking up stride entering the lane and rallied belatedly to miss place. MISTER BANDERAS raced towards the rear along the inside, paused behind a rival into the turn, progressed in the three path into the lane and rallied willingly. STUDENY bumped an inner rival at the start, saved ground while pursuing from midpack and chased evenly. GALLO DE FUEGO transferred contact from an outer rival to an inner foe at the start, tracked from the two to three path and gave way. LOTTERY WIN stalked from the three path, took aim along with an inner rival while entering the lane in the four path, but lacked a bid and faded. FLY J'S FUNTASTIC chased form midpack in the four path, spun to the five path entering the lane and tired. MUNSON was jostled between rivals and steadied back soon after the start, raced well back two wide and failed to factor. BIG LUCKY bumped with an inner rival leaving the gate, then bumped an outer foe soon after the start, lacked speed along the inside and got outrun.
