SINISTER SMILE prompted two wide, vied turning for home, gained an advantage whlie still well in hand reaching the lane, then kicked away in upper stretch and drew off under little urging. NYQUIST FREQUENCY bobbled slightly leaving the gate, tracked two wide and between horses, pursued under rousing in the three path around the turn, claimed place after the leader kicked clear in upper stretch and proved second best. BON TEMPS set the pace as the eventual winner applied firm pressure, got headed by that one entering the lane, quickly proved no match, faded yet safely managed show. PREPOSITION broke a step slow, progressed to be close up along the inside while coming under a snug hold behind the leaders entering the backstretch, settled into stalking stride shortly after, but only managed to chase the leaders from the two to three path in upper stretch and yielded. POST GAME trailed in the two path and failed to menace. MOR SUCCESS chased from the four path, faded passing the three furlong pole and was done early.

CHADO showed the way along the inside, met an outer challenge turning for home and held firm through the lane. DELTA TAU CHI broke a step slow, recovered to chase closest to the eventual winner and from the three path into the turn, crept closer to issue a bid nearing the lane, but was kept at bay through the final furlong. TRACK RANGER rushed forward after a flat-footed beginning, tracked from midpack two wide and between horses, chased three wide into the final furlong and stayed on to edge show late. VIX broke a step slow, steadied behind a faltering foe and got shuffled back leaving the five furlong pole, laid well back in the two path around the turn, bided time while encountering traffic behind foes into the lane, then stayed on between horses in the final furlong to bid for show but got outkicked for that position. SOCO AND LIME stalked along the inside, willingly chased the top through midstretch but yielded show to an outer pair late. SILENT BREEZE failed to sustain forwardly position and dropped back soon after the start, raced off of the pace in the four to five path and failed to menace. BERNIEDOTT pursued from midpack three wide, chased in the four path into the lane and gave way. SILVER SCREEN dropped back and faltered with five furlongs to go, trailed in the four path around the turn and showed little.

COLONIAL ROSE bumped an outer rival early on, dropped back to the rear while steadying inside of foes approaching the first turn, yet progressed to take closer order with nine sixteenths to go, stalked behind the top pair around the far turn, tipped outside of them passing the five sixteenths pole, bid in upper stretch, gained command at the furlong grounds and drove clear. WHERE'S THE WINE pressed two wide, bid and gained an advantage at the five sixteenths pole, led as an outer rival bid in upper stretch, got caught by that one at the furlong grounds and was second best. GILA tracked three wide into the backstretch, chased between rivals around the far turn, got floated out to the six path entering the lane, sustained stride while shifting in and kept on to surpass a tiring foe for show in the final furlong. WINDY WALK was off a bit awkwardly, then took simultaneous contact on both sides and got squeezed back early on, recovered to pursue from midpack in the two path, then between horses with nine sixteenths to go before behind held up behind foes into the far turn, shifted out sharply to the five path entering the lane, chased to edge show in upper stretch but lacked a bid and faded. ASIAN MATRIARCH raced off of the pace while hung four wide, got floated to the six to seven path entering the lane and failed to factor. CLASSIC PERFORMER bumped an inner rival early on, set the pace along the inside, got headed by an outer presser passing the five sixteenths pole, faltered quickly nearing midstretch, was pulled up in the final furlong and walked off.

STANDOUTSENSATION stalked along the inside while bottled up under a snug hold, awaited racing room around the far turn, steadied behind a tiring rival entering the lane, split foes two wide shortly after to bid inside of the leader in upper stretch, inched ahead as an outer CHILLED kept aim in midstretch, dueled with that bidder into the final sixteenth but got bested. LITTLE JAMIE trailed in the three path, advanced four wide around the far turn, took aim on the leader entering the lane, issued a bid for place along with an outer foe coming to midstretch, but got outkicked at the furlong grounds and proved best of the rest. LEMON MUFFIN pursued from midpack in the four path, progressed to issue an early bid for the lead with nine sixteenths to go, forged an advantage while tucking two wide passing the three furlong pole, led in the three path in upper stretch, but was bested between bidders approaching midstretch and faded. SULTRY LASS raced off of the pace hung five wide early on, advanced approaching the far turn to be within striking range outside of the top pair passing the three furlong pole, but flattened out between rivals entering the lane and tired. PRETTY LAYLA set the pace near the inside while tugging in the bit into and around the first turn, clung to an advantage from a trio of outer rivals with nine sixteenths to go, but got headed at the three furlong pole, gave way turning for home and weakened. CATMINT laid off of the pace along the inside, moved out to the three to five path around the far turn and failed to factor. WINDY BAY pressed two wide, then between horses with nine sixteenths to go, but failed to sustain pressure after being brushed into the far turn, chased among foes around the far turn and faded entering the lane.

EMERGENCE pursued from midpack along the inside, tipped outside of the top pair while looming a danger turning for home, swept past them with five sixteenths to go, drew off under a drive and was put to wraps with a sixteenth to go. DOMINGO stalked nearing the inside, then outside of the leader around the second turn, pressed down the backstretch, led narrowly while in hand passing the three furlong pole, but got overhauled by an outer challenge leaving the five sixteenths marker, dueled for place with his inner counterpart through the lane and prevailed. PRESIDER showed the way near the inside, felt pressure from an outer rival down the backstretch, got headed by that one at the three furlong pole, then was quickly overhauled by a wider challenger turning for home, battled for place thereafter but was fended off. MALCOLM X (PER) laid off of the pace along the inside, shifted out to the three to four path around the final turn, improved to claim fourth in upper stretch and failed to threaten the top trio. THE HIDDEN CHAMBER laid off of the pace two wide, came under urging along the inside around the final turn and lacked a bid. FORT THOMAS brushed with a rival on both sides while pursuing from the four path and between horses around the first turn, backed off three wide into the backstretch, retreated to trail in the four path around the second turn, improved in the two path around the final bend but failed to factor. MIDNIGHT CHANNEL stalked in the three path while brushing with an outer foe around the first turn, dropped back down the backstretch, weakened around the final turn and was eased through the lane. INDY CHARGES ON dueled for the lead with an outer rival, got outkicked by a wider bidder in midstretch, sustained the battle for place and shared that position at the wire. MO GO vied two wide, dueled around the far turn, got outkicked by an outer rival at the furlong grounds, battled for place thereafter and dead-heated. DEREK'S LAW stalked three wide, got outkicked by an inner rival while getting floated to the four path into the lane and stayed on mildly. ASK ARTHUR broke slowly, raced off of the pace in the two path, came under urging in the three path around the far turn and failed to menace. SHORTSTOP pursued from midpack along the inside, chased in the two path around the far turn and lacked a bid. MUGATU trailed in the four path, fanned out to the seven path into the lane and made little impact.
