ENCRYPT bumped with an outer rival at the start, pursued from midpack in the two to three path into the backstretch, progressed in the four path into the far turn, ranged up quickly to issue a bold challenge outside of the top pair passing the three furlong pole, drew clear shortly after and held sway through the final furlong. KEVIN'S STRIKE stalked near the inside, chased the leading trio around the far turn, got brushed and floated out to the four to five path by an inner rival entering upper stretch, ran on to bid for place in midstretch, exchanged contact again while doing so yet edged place shortly after. STRATEGIST pressed the leader from the three path while pulling keenly around the first turn, sustained pressured in the two path down the backstretch, bid along with an outer rival at the three furlong pole, but got swiftly outkicked turning for home, shifted out to the three path before chasing inside of a pair of foes leaving upper stretch, leaned out and bumped a rival at the furlong grounds, got outkicked once again yet held show late. BEMBRIDGE LEDGE broke out and brushed a foe at the start, pressed two wide, bid and vied around the far turn, sparred with the early leader through midstretch then edged ahead in the final sixteenth. RUNNING GAME set the pace as the eventual winner applied outer pressure, vied with that one around the far turn, dueled gamely through the lane, but was bested late then saved place from an outer foe at the wire. HELLO BEAUTY stalked along the inside, chased the embattled leading pair from the two to three path through upper stretch, tipped to take aim from the four path into the final sixteenth, closed in late but missed place at the wire. MO EXPECTATIONS broke a step slow, brushed with an outer rival and stumbled at the start, settled off of the pace along the inside, came under urging with a half mile to go, took the far turn in the two path, rallied between rivals into the final furlong and ran on willingly along the inside late. SHEILA'S LION brushed with an inner foe leaving the gate, got keen early on before settling well back two wide, took the far turn in the three path, swung out to the six path into the lane, picked up stride floating to the eight path in upper stretch and rallied willingly to reach a minor share at the wire.

STAR BLESSING (IRE) tracked two wide, then from the three path around the far turn, chased in the four path in upper stretch while hanging on his left lead, changed over and faded between horses at the furlong grounds. SUN LIGHTNING tracked along the inside, chased in upper stretch and faded. THERAVADA raced off of the pace four to three wide around the first turn, improved in the four path around the far turn, but flattened out in the six to seven path and between foes in upper stretch. JEWELED CITY settled off of the pace two wide and made little impact. VINO BELLA broke slowly and was last away, trailed in the two path and got outrun.

WINTERS LION laid off of the pace near the inside, then in the three path around the far turn, ran on mildly in the final furlong and edged fourth late. KING RUSSELL stalked along the inside, chased around the far turn, pursued in the three to four path and between horses in upper stretch, vied for show into the final furlong but got outkicked then missed fourth. REBEL RED (GB) settled well back in the two path, swung out to the seven path into the lane, rallied while hanging on his left lead, changed over before bidding leaving the furlong grounds, gained an advantage at the sixteenth pole and drew clear. HIGHWAY ROBBER laid off of the pace along the inside, then in the two path around the second turn, crept closer in the three path around the final bend, fanned out to the five path entering the lane, rallied to bid in upper stretch, vied into the final furlong, but got outkicked by an outer rival at the sixteenth pole. VERSTAPPEN pursued from midpack two wide, got floated to the four path passing the five furlong pole, tracked three deep around the final turn, pursued in the four path into upper stretch, but got outkicked shortly after, ran on between rivals in the final furlong and gained show late. LAMBETH cleared off early on, met an outer challenge at the half mile pole, vied with that one around the final turn, fought on as outer rivals bid into midstretch, but yielded with a sixteenth to go and missed show. GOLDENEYE tracked along the inside, shifted out passing the five furlong pole, progressed three wide to bid shortly after, vied two wide around the final bend, battled between horses into midstretch but yielded late. ANGLOPHILE stalked along the inside, got outmoved to be midpack approaching the far turn, awaited racing room in the two path turning for home, shifted out to the five path into the lane and failed to menace. UTAH BEACH settled well back along the inside, saved ground, shifted out to the six path entering the lane, got outkicked while pursuing mildly between horses in upper stretch, checked while flopping back to his left lead in the final furlong and lacked a bid. SUGOI stalked two wide, chased in upper stretch and faded. TAPIT SHOES dropped back into the first turn then trailed throughout. This quarter mile fraction was originally hand timed and has been re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
