EXPLOSIVELY tracked two wide, then from the three path around the turn, took aim on the new leader from the five path entering upper stretch and ran on to chase that one home and prove second best. SPRINT OUT PASS lacked speed in the four path, fanned out to the six path into the lane, yet rallied willingly to edge show in the final sixteenth. FARM TEAM pursued off of the pace from the three path, chased in the four path in upper stretch, stayed on bid for show along with an outer rival in the final sixteenth but got outkicked. OUTDOOR CAT broke a beat slow, rushed inside of rivals early on to track along the inside with a half mile to go, then only managed to chase mildly through midstretch and yielded show to an outer pair late. CAJUN CRUISER tracked along the inside, took closer order passing the five furlong pole, stalked behind the top pair around the bend then chased willingly through the final furlong. SET ABOUT lacked speed two wide, bumped an inner rival into the turn before tipping three wide shortly after, crept closer under urging turning for home, moved out to the five path in upper stretch, but leveled off before flopping back to his left lead due to a right handed crop in the final sixteenth. LIVEHAPPY brushed with an outer foe leaving the gate, prompted two wide, vied around the turn, but yielded in the three path in upper stretch and tired between horses. GOOD NEWS ROCKET brushed with an inner foe at the start, raced at the rear along the inside, bumped with an outer foe into the turn, then saved ground to no avail. IMPERIAL GUN brushed with an outer foe leaving the gate, tracked along the inside, then from the two path around the turn, tipped inwardly to take rail aim in upper stretch, slipped through in the final furlong to bid at the sixteenth pole and drove past. MAP TO THE STARS stalked in the three path, moved to press outside of the leader along with an outer foe into the turn, bid and forged an advantage while floating to the four path into the lane, held firm from the inner persistent early leader through midstretch but was caught by an inner bidder in the final sixteenth. BOURBON'S FAULT set the pace in the two path, felt pressure from an outer pair into and around the turn, got headed while spinning to the three path entering the lane, fought on well through midstretch, but got outkicked by an inner bidder late and was denied place. ## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

BRIGHT LEAF trailed early on, advanced in the four to five path nearing the lane and rallied to sweep past the leader at the sixteenth pole. APPEAL DENIED stalked three wide, bid entering the lane, led in upper stretch but was overhauled by an outer challenger at the sixteenth pole. SOUTHERN SUNSET pressed two wide early on, failed to sustain pressure and chased the leader into the turn, moved to the inside turning for home, then lacked a bid. PAY ZONE bobbled subtly at the start, set the pace along the inside, got headed by an outer challenger while drifting to the three path into upper stretch and faded. KANT BEAT THE ROCK leaned outwardly and checked back at the start, raced off of the pace along the inside and failed to factor. CRITICAL THREAT pursued from midpack along the inside, chased while shifting out in upper stretch and failed to factor. READY PURSUIT lacked speed two wide and got outrun.
