SWEET STAR was a bit slow into stride, laid off of the pace along the inside, then two wide at the three furlong pole, progressed along with an outer rival in upper stretch, shifted out to maintain aim outside of the lugging leader passing the furlong grounds, but brushed her outer counterpart in the process, sustained her rally to bid along with that one at the sixteenth pole but got outkicked. NAME DROPPER broke a step slow, raced off of the pace along the inside before moving two wide and between rivals at the half mile pole, shifted out to the four path at the three furlong marker, got fanned out to the seven path into the lane, yet rallied to bid at the furlong grounds and edged ahead late. CINNAMON SUGAR tracked from midpack in the two to three path, shifted out to the five to six path entering the lane, rallied while moving back inwardly before bidding along with an outer foe at the furlong grounds, vied with that one while headed into the final sixteenth and got bested. SUPER PACHI broke on top but yielded position to outer rivals early on, laid off of the pace along the inside, shifted out while pursuing behind foes in upper stretch, briefly aimed between rivals at the furlong grounds before tipping wider shortly after, then ran on well. HIGH SOUTH stalked close up along the inside, tipped to the three path to take aim outside of the clear leader in upper stretch, sustained gradual progress to reel that one in at the sixteenth pole and edged past. TAP THE CHAMPAGNE set the pace two wide before moving to the inside around the first turn, shook clear of an outer presser reaching the lane, held sway from an outer pursing HIGH SOUTH through midstretch, but was collared by that one at the sixteenth pole and got bested. SCARLETTA CARPETTA saved ground while pursuing from midpack, claimed show from outer rivals at the three sixteenths pole, shifted out in midstretch with multiple lengths to find on the top pair and stayed on but needed more. UNION ROSE steadied between rivals early on, trailed along the inside, then in the two path around the far turn, shifted out to the seven path in upper stretch and rallied to reach fourth at the sixteenth pole. PLOT broke a step slow before being put to tight quarters between horses at the start, settled well back in the two path, took the far turn in the three path before shifting back down two wide in upper stretch, and moved up approaching the furlong grounds. TWO TURNTABLES brushed with an outer foe at the start, tracked two wide and between horses, but briefly shuffled turning for home, chased in the three path into upper stretch, but lacked a bid and yielded between rivals. ABITIBI showed the way while remaining in the three path around the turn, dug in to resist an inner challenge approaching midstretch, repelled that foe in the final sixteenth and held firm as an outer rival closed in late. DE' ANS EIGHTY bobbled at the start, raced off of the pace hung out to the five path, pursued while tipping to the six path in upper stretch and rallied to reach place at the wire. TAPAKENA brushed an outer rival at the start, stalked along the inside, awaited racing room before moving three wide and between foes turning for home, progressed to take aim on the leader from the five path entering the lane, assumed command in upper stretch and drove clear. SPY vied three wide, bumped with an inner foe down the backstretch, drew clear with five sixteenths to go, but proved no match for an outer rival approaching midstretch and was second best. HARBE stalked five to four wide into the turn, pursued within striking range turning for home, but got outkicked by an inner rival while floating to the six path entering the lane, shifted in to chase the top pair in upper stretch and held show through the final furlong. FLAMBEAU bumped with an inner foe leaving the gate, raced off of the pace two wide, advanced while shifting out to the six path in upper stretch and ran on to be denied show. ONE DESTINATION broke a step slow and was brushed by an inner rival leaving he gate, lagged well behind into the turn, rejoined the rest while entering the lane in the four path and moved up between horses. KEEPING THE FAITH bobbled slightly at the start, vied with a pair of outer rivals into the turn, but gave
