COMMANDED steady entering the backstretch while ceding the front to an outer pair, tugged while laying close up behind the leader down the backstretch checking passing the five furlong pole, settled into stalking stride into the turn, altered course outside of the leader in upper stretch, sustained a grinding charge and wore down that rival in the closing stages. DARK FURY set the pace along the inside, inched free of an outer presser in upper stretch, maintained a margin from a pursuing COMMANDED through midstretch, but was collared by that one in the final sixteenth and gave in. APPEALING ADDIE pursued from midpack in the two path, shifted inwardly in upper stretch, claimed show from an outer pair at the furlong grounds and stayed on. MOMBAYLA raced off of the pace in the three path, floated to the four path in upper stretch and ran on evenly. SWEET BEBSI trailed near the inside, shifted out to the five path in upper stretch and failed to factor. SABRINA pressed two wide, but gave way in the three path in upper stretch and weakened between horses.

LONGSHOREMAN built a clear advantage with a half mile to go, led well traveling well in hand with his ears pricked around the turn, kicked away when set down in upper stretch and was ridden out under mild urging. STRONG tracked two wide, shifted out to the four to five path in upper stretch, ran on to bid for place at the furlong grounds, sparred with an inner rival for that position thereafter and edged past. THEBABESLAYER stalked closest to the clear leader from the two path, proved no match before meeting an outer challenge for place in midstretch, dug in and dueled gamely, but was bested. SIGNATORY MAN (IRE) was bumped by an outer foe leaving the gate, steadied when put to cramped quarters between horses early on, recovered off of the pace, got floated out to the four path by a rank rival into the turn, tucked down to the three path before swinging out to the six path entering the lane, then rallied willingly while flopping back to his left lead in the final furlong. DA PRINCE IS RIGHT bumped an inner rival at the start, laid well back tucking to the inside into the turn, shifted out and advanced in the six path and between horses in midstretch and moved up. ZEUS'S ECHO leaned outwardly at the start, pursued from midpack in the three to four path and failed to menace. HAPPY PRINCE tracked along the inside, chased in upper stretch and yielded. SPEAKING IN CURSIV dropped back along the the inside, got rank from rider's restraint when corrected from lugging outwardly into the turn, raced well back in the two path and made little impact. BAYTOWN ANUBIS pursued from midpack two wide and between horses, sustained pursuit from the two path

around the turn and faded. DR. MY EYES steadied slightly soon after the start, raced at the rear in the three path around the turn, shifted wider into upper stretch and got outrun.

TROUBLE'S ROARING brushed with an inner rival leaving the gate, tracked near the inside, took aim inside of the leader entering the lane, slipped through and gained command leaving upper stretch, drove clear passing the furlong grounds and held sway. THE CHALK pressed the leader from the three path along with an outer foe into and around the turn, got outkicked by an inner rival while maintaining aim between horses in upper stretch, ran on to reclaim place leaving the furlong grounds and was second best. LIAM'S LAGOON brushed with an outer foe at the start, showed the way near the inside, led from an outer pair of pressers while remaining a path off of the inside around the turn, but met an inner challenge in upper stretch, got headed reaching midstretch and gave way through the final furlong yet lasted for show. VEX raced off of the pace in the four to five path and stayed on willingly. RAVENS DREAM leaned inwardly and checked from rider's correction at the start, stalked three deep, applied pressure on the top pair from the four path around the turn, but faded in upper stretch. ANCIENT HISTORY broke slowly, trailed in the two path and failed to factor. ZAPPO checked out of crowded quarters between horses at the start, raced off of the pace in the three to four path and tired.

ESMARK laid off of the pace along the inside, shifted out turning for home, swung to the five path into the lane, rallied to issue a bid outside of the new leader in the final sixteenth and got up at the wire. SEVEN WONDERS leaned outwardly leaving the gate, pursued from midpack in the two path, briefly awaited racing room entering the lane, got brushed by an inner rival into an outer foe while pursuing in the three path and between horses in upper stretch, ran on to bid inside of the faltering leader at the sixteenth pole, led shortly after but was caught by an outer bidder in the shadow of the wire. KING PEANUT broke outwardly, stalked four wide, vied three deep and from the four path around the turn, got floated to the five path while sparring into the lane, but got outkicked between rivals leaving midstretch and secured show. INTERLOCK EMPIRE pressed two wide and between horses, vied in the three path while between a pair around the turn, turned for home with a narrow advantage before shifting out to the four path into the lane, battled on through upper stretch but yielded between horses in the final furlong. GOD OF WINE set the pace along the inside, got headed by an outer pair at the three furlong pole, chased them into the lane and through midstretch but gave way in the final furlong. SCHIFTY'S HALOID raced off of the pace in the five path, fanned to the seven path into the lane before shifting down in upper stretch and moved up. AIRBORNE ELITE tracked three wide, took aim on the leader from the five path in upper stretch, gained an advantage at the furlong grounds and drove clear. RULEROFTHEUNIVERSE raced off of the pace in teh four to five path, shifted wider in upper stretch and rallied willingly to reach place late. YOU AIN'T POPPN bumped an inner foe at the start, stalked two wide, pressed around the turn, led in the four path into the lane, but got caught by an outer bidder at the furlong grounds and yielded. VERTRAUEN bumped an outer rival leaving the gate, set the pace under strong restraint early on, led from an outer presser around the turn, got headed by that one entering the lane and faded. ONE MOR STORY raced forwardly along the inside, tracked around the turn, chased in the two path in upper stretch and lacked a bid. METALHEAD raced off of the pace in the two path and failed to factor. GRAYDARIA was bumped between horses and pinched back at the start, raced at the rear of the group along the inside, took the turn in the two to three path and made little impact. PRIVATE RESERVE leaned outwardly at the start, lost contact with the rest early on, lagged behind while remaining wide around the turn then was eased through the lane and walked off.
