

GOLD SEARCH set the pace in the two path, was coaxed from the rail nearing the quarter, and kept on down the lane to hold safe. ATLANTIC DANCER had a slow start, rated inside, was roused in upper stretch, ran on to bid from the two path in the final sixteenth, but ran out of time. AIR CAV bumped with an inner foe at the start, stalked in the three path, was cued in the two path midway around the turn, swung from the four path into the lane, but was one paced. PIERCE ELEVATED tracked in the three path, was coaxed along around the turn, angled out to the five path passing the eighth pole, but made no final bid. ORTHO STAR bumped with an outer foe at the start, chased in the two path and made no impact.

MUGATU trailed in the two path, was driven in the three path around the far turn, angled out to the seven path in upper stretch, rallied outside of foes to take command passing the sixteenth pole, and drew clear. ARMY HERO bumped with an inner foe at the start, rated in the two path, waited along the rail around the far turn, was roused from the three path at the top of the lane, and ran on. SPEED INSTITUTE laid up close in the three path, bid around the far turn, led in the four path at the top of the stretch, but drifted out passing the eighth pole, and was caught around the sixteenth. SHATTUCK raced off the pace in the three path, was driven between foes around the far turn, floated out to the six path in upper stretch, and weakened in the final furlong. FARLEY HALL set the pace in the two path, but lost the lead passing the quarter, and yielded down the stretch. QUEBRANCHO stalked in the four path but weakened. BORN FLASHY tracked in the three path but retreated. BOURBON OUTLAW bumped with an outer foe at the start, chased in the four path but never threatened.

DARK THIRTY broke out and bumped an outer foe, raced off the pace inside but made no impact. ASHES AND DIAMONDS got bumped at the start, chased in the four path but was no factor in the seven path down the stretch. DARTY TIME prompted the pace in the four path, was ridden in the three path around the turn, floated out to the six path at the top of the stretch, and weakened.
