LEMON ZEST stalked two wide while moving outside of the leader down the backstretch, pursued while perched in the four path around the turn, ranged up turning for home to offer a bid entering the lane, was kept at bay through upper stretch, yet sustained her bid to forge an advantage at the sixteenth pole, flopped back to her left lead while moving away from her inner counterpart and edged clear. MARGARITA GIRL led while remaining wide entering the backstretch, crossed over to the two path with five furlongs to go, showed the way as an outer pair pursued around the turn, met an outer challenge entering the lane, maintained a margin confidently before being set down passing the three sixteenths marker, gamely clung to an advantage while getting collared leaving the furlong grounds, but was headed at the sixteenth pole and was second best. BUNDLE transferred light contact from an outer rival to an inner foe at the start, tracked from midpack in the three path, shifted out to the five path while progressing into the lane and ran on willingly. STRONG DESTINY broke inwardly and brushed a rival at the start, raced forwardly along the inside into the backstretch, stalked along with an outer rival while moving outside of the leader and to the three path into the turn, but failed to issue a bid along with her outer counterpart nearing the lane, chased between horses into the stretch and gave way. IN THE STARS was brushed by an outer rival leaving the gate, raced at the rear along the inside before progressing with five furlongs to go, took closer order to track from midpack along the inside around the turn, but came under urging chasing into the lane, flattened out and tired. BUCKLE CHASER lacked speed in the three path, trailed along the inside around the turn and failed to factor. DANCING DRUMS leaned outwardly when the gates sprung, raced off of the pace in the four path and weakened.

GUN PARTY prompted two wide, vied around the far turn, forged an advantage while spinning to the four path into the lane, shifted inwardly in upper stretch and drove clear at the furlong grounds. RAGUEL set the pace as the eventual winner applied firm outer pressure, vied with that one around the far turn, got headed while entering the lane in the two path, was floated inwardly while fighting on in upper stretch, but proved no match at the furlong grounds and managed place. GAMBLERS TAIL tracked along the inside, moved to the two path at the five furlong pole, chased the embattled leading pair around the far turn, shifted out to the four path while sustaining pursuit at the three sixteenths pole and ran on to best of the rest. FIRST PLAYER tracked two wide, then from the three path down the backstretch, chased the top pair while coming under urging around the far turn, then tired in the five path in upper stretch. SUN THUNDER saved ground off of the pace, then lacked progress and missed reeling in a tiring outer foe for fourth. SHOPPER'S REVENGE lacked speed two wide, moved out in upper stretch and made little impact.

IT AIN'T LIKE THAT pressed outside of the eventual winner, failed to sustain pressure and chased in upper stretch, sustained pursuit and sparred with an inner rival for place through the final furlong, then shared that position at the wire. SUGAREE broke a step slow, recovered to advance to an inside stalking position early on, chased the clearing leader along with an outer rival in upper stretch, battled for place with that one through the final furlong and dead-heated for that position. AMAZING AMANDA raced off of the pace while remaining a path off of the inside, moved out to the four path before shifting back to the two path in midstretch and stayed on mildly to move up. COMMAND THE STARS hopped at the start, raced off of the pace in the three path, shifted out turning for home before swinging to the six path into the lane and improved mildly. MINIMALIST broke a beat slow, gained five wide and outside of rivals into the turn, progressed to take aim on place while tucking three wide into the lane, but emptied out and weakened while drifting on her left lead through the lane. EMILY'S JOY tracked from the three path and between horses, shifted out to the five path entering the lane but lacked a rally between rivals. PERCY'S BAR raced off of the pace in the three to two path, launched progress in the three path into the turn, ranged up outside of the leading trio to issue a bold four wide challenge entering the lane, took charge shortly after, kicked clear and held sway. JABOSS bumped the gate and was off slow, trailed in the three path, advanced between horses passing the three furlong pole, swung out to the five path into the lane and sustained her charge to edge place in midstretch. COLOR COMIN' IN prompted three deep, got outkicked by an outer rival while inching place entering the lane, but yielded that position to an outer rival in midstretch and held show late. AMERICATHEGREAT lacked speed while remaining a path off of the inside, shifted out to the six path into upper stretch and ran on willingly. LILIES N PARADISE raced forwardly four wide before tucking behind the leading trio with a half mile to go, stalked while awaiting racing room in the two path around the bend, tipped out four wide into the lane, stayed on to bid for place between horses leaving upper stretch, but flattened out and gave way. LIGHT WON UP was hustled to vie between horses early on, brushed an inner rival while securing position reaching the five furlong pole, led narrowly two wide and between horses around the turn, offered no resistance to a wider challenge entering the lane and faded. ESSENTIAL COFFEE veered inwardly shortly after the start, prompted along the inside, got brushed by an outer rival and subtly checked reaching the five furlong pole, yet sustained position in the aftermath, vied inside of a pair of rivals around the turn, faded inside of a trio of foes entering the lane and caved. MINE STRIKE brushed the starting gate and bobbled at the start, pursued from midpack in the four to five path, weakened with three furlongs to go and was eased through the lane.

WILL TAKE IT raced off of the pace three wide and between horses, tracked from midpack around the bend, shifted to take aim from the five path and between horses into upper stretch, sustained gradual progress to vie into the final furlong, forged a narrow advantage leaving that station and held firm from an inner persistent counterpart. BANISHING bumped an outer rival leaving the gate, set a pressured pace, vied inside of a pair of rivals while taking the turn in the three path, dug in between horses in upper stretch, dueled while getting headed by an outer challenger at the furlong grounds, fought on doggedly thereafter but was kept at bay. EXTRA ANEJO tracked along the inside, offered a rail bid in upper stretch, vied with a pair of outer rivals into the final furlong, but yielded late and lasted for show. TUMBARUMBA raced off of the pace two wide and between horses, moved out to the four path around the turn, swung out to the six to seven path in upper stretch and ran on late to miss show at the wire. CAGLIOSTRO raced off of the pace in the five path, advanced with a half mile to go, pressed the top pair from the five path around the turn, evened out while floating to the six path into the lane, got outkicked by an inner foe and chased thereafter. JUDGE MILLER transferred contact from an inner foe to an outer rival at the start, laid off of the pace along the inside, moved out to the four path into the lane and failed to menace. SAUDI CROWN stalked in the four path, bid outside of the leader while still in the four path into the turn, vied between rivals around the bend, then weakened between horses in midstretch. BEST ACTOR was brushed by an inner foe at the start, raced forwardly two wide and between horses, chased around the turn and faded nearing the lane.

PIN UP BETTY bobbled subtly and was bumped by an inner rival into an outer foe at the start, laid off of the pace in the three path, gained in the four path turning for home, fanned to the five path entering the lane, sustained her gradual progress to bid in midstretch and edged past before holding late. DUVET DAY (IRE) settled at the rear along the inside, then in the two path around the far turn, swung out to the five to six path into upper stretch and rallied in the final furlong to reach place in the shadow of the wire. LONG AGO (GB) brushed with an inner rival at the start, tracked the top pair from the two path, crept into striking range three deep around the far turn, bid along with an outer rival in midstretch, vied leaving the furlong grounds, but was bested in the final sixteenth and lost place late. SPARKLE BLUE saved ground off of the pace, chased in the two path in upper stretch, tipped outwardly in the final furlong and stayed on between horses late. CHARLENE'S DREAM was bumped by an inner rival soon after the start, pressed two wide, stalked down the backstretch before rebidding around the far turn, forged an advantage in upper stretch, but was collared by an outer pair at the furlong grounds and yielded. EVERLAND broke outwardly and bumped a foe at the start, raced at the rear two wide, then in the three path around teh far turn, fanned out to the six to eight path into upper stretch and failed to menace. GENEROUS LOVER brushed with an outer rival leaving the gate, set the pace along the inside through quick splits, vied with an outer bidder turning for home, got headed in upper stretch and weakened.

VERIFIRE stalked three wide, prompted around the turn, vied nearing the lane, dueled with an inner counterpart into the final furlong and drove clear. SMOKEN WICKED prompted two wide, vied between horses around the turn, dueled and battled inside of the eventual winner into the final furlong, but got bested and managed place. CAPTAIN COOK set the pace along the inside, vied with an outer pair around the turn, got headed in upper stretch, yielded to those rivals at the furlong grounds, shifted out and kept on. RETRIBUTION tracked two wide and between horses, chased in the three path around the turn,

proved no match for the leading trio in upper stretch yet stayed on mildly to claim fourth. SPEED KING bumped with an outer foe at the start, pursued from midpack three wide and between horses, tracked in the four path around the turn, fanned to the five path while chasing into the lane and lacked a bid while hanging on his left lead. ANCIENT WORLD laid close up along the inside, stalked around the bend, shifted four wide into the lane, but lacked a bid and faded between horses. FLOOD ZONE bumped with an inner foe at the start, lagged behind the rest down the backstretch, improved in the four to six path into the final furlong and moved up. KALE'S ANGEL pursued from midpack in the four path, then faded in the five path around the turn. FURIO raced off of the pace in the five path, the in the four path and between horses at the three furlong pole, tucked down two wide in upper stretch, leaned inwardly and brushed a foe in midstretch, then failed to factor. MAX GOT EXCITED raced off of the pace in the three path and between horses, cut the corner entering the lane, was brushed into tight rail quarters by an outer foe in midstretch and made little impact. NORMANDY COAST chased from midpack along the inside, then weakened before being eased through the final furlong.

MASSARAT settled well back in the three to four path, progressed four wide around the far turn, took aim from the five path into the lane then bid and drove

clear at the furlong grounds. TWOLATEBABYDOLL (FR) brushed with an inner rival at the start, steadied among foes into the first turn, tracked two wide and between rivals, aimed between the leaders entering the lane, issued a rail bid before getting outkicked at the furlong grounds, yet kept on to prove second best. GOOD GAME settled well back in the two path, took the far turn in the three path before swinging to the seven path entering the lane, floated wider in upper stretch yet rallied willingly thereafter. MISS PHARAOH pursued from midpack along the inside, then in the two path around the far turn, shifted out to the four to five path and between rivals entering the lane then ran on evenly. GRAYLEIGH pursued from midpack in the four to three path, inched closer three wide turning for home, took aim from the four path and between horses entering the lane, vied for show in the final furlong but yielded late. KIMBER SPICE brushed with an outer rival leaving the gate, stalked along the inside, checked off of the leader's heels into the far turn, encountered traffic two wide into the lane and lacked a bid along the inside. STRAIGHT FORWARD brushed an inner foe at the start, stalked three deep, bid around the far turn, led nearing the lane, but got outkicked between rivals in midstretch and weakened. MAPLE SYRUP was brushed by an outer foe into an inner rival at the start, eased out of tight quarters shortly after then shied from an inner foe early on, laid off of the pace in the three path, then between horses around teh far turn, shifted out to the five to seven path into the lane and lacked a kick. MERRY MADISON was brushed between horses and squeezed back soon after the start, trailed along the inside, then in the three path before swinging to the six path into the lane and failed to factor. HOPE DIAMOND was brushed between horses at the start, pressed two wide, vied between horses around the far turn but faltered in upper stretch. MARBLE ARCH brushed with an outer rival at the start, saved ground off of the
