SHINOBU broke sharply and set the pace then opened up on the turn and was roused at the top of the stretch, drawing away to win easily. VALIDIDA rated in the second flight early with a rail trip then waited through the turn then slipped through along the inside into the stretch and rallied late for place. MADDY MANIA rated in the middle of the pack early then angled out at the 1/4 pole and looked for room, splitting horses mid-stretch and was full of run late. NEWHOPE rated in the second flight early between horses then altered five wide nearing the 1/8 pole and made a bid between horses, gaining late. KABIN EIGHT rated in the middle of the pack early, racing four wide through the turn then altered eight wide into the stretch and made a mild rally late. ALLIEMAE was hustled away and chased the pace along the inside then battled into the stretch but was outfinished late. PEACE MISSION was void of early speed with a five wide trip through the turn then angled nine wide into the stretch and closed willingly. ALOHA KIM got squeezed at the start and showed no speed

early then ducked in at the 3/16 pole and made a mild rally late. FAN'S CHOICE got off a step slowly and settled then circled while six wide on the turn but failed to sustain that bid into the stretch. SHARPLY was reluctant to load into the gate then chased the pace while three wide early and contended for a half mile then gave way in the stretch. STIRRUP was void of early speed then made a four wide bid nearing the 3/8 pole but flattened out in the stretch.

STORM CLOUD RISING chased early while altering off the rail to race to the outside of LOCKDOWNYOURTOWN then ranged up on the turn and loomed boldly before battling through the stretch run and prevailing at the wire. NOROOMFORMISCHIEF rated in the middle of the pack early then circled while five wide on the turn and sustained that rally through the stretch to get up late for place. LOCKDOWNYOURTOWN broke inward and bumped HOLLYBYGOLLY at the start then cleared the early lead before being engaged by STORM CLOUD RISING on the turn and battled through the long stretch drive but was outfinished late. BELLE OFTHE DANCE got off slowly and settled then was urged along at the 1/2 pole and angled five wide at the 1/4 pole, gaining belatedly late. HOLLYBYGOLLY got bumped at the start by LOCKDOWNYOURTOWN then dropped back and saved ground into the stretch, gaining late along the inside. MOM'S CHEESECAKE rated in the second flight early while three wide and chased to the 1/4 pole but made no rally in the stretch. HEARTBEAT rated in the second flight early with a rail trip then was asked along the inside into the turn but had no response.

ELEWENE got away alertly and set the pace then tucked in shortly after the start for the run along the backstretch before being roused at the 1/4 pole and opened up in the stretch, winning while ridden out through the wire. VALKYRIE was allowed to settle early and waited through the turn then split horses at the 1/8 pole and rallied late for place. SHARPIE GIRL was reluctant to load into the gate then chased the pace while three wide and ranged up to make a bid at the 1/4 pole and made a mild rally late. MARBLEHEAD settled early then loomed while four wide on the turn before making a five wide bid at the 1/4 pole but faltered in the stretch. CRUISIN IN HARMONY got off a step slowly at the start then was rushed up along the inside to challenge but brushed the rail at the 5/8 pole then was shut off and steadied behind ELEWENE before trying to come again along the inside into the turn but lacked room again while never clear then the rider lost the whip at the 1/4 pole and gave way. THE RIDER OF CRUISIN IN HARMONY CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF ELEWENE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE NEAR THE 5/8 POLE. FOLLOWING A REVIEW BY THE STEWARDS NO CHANGE WAS MADE.

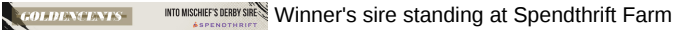

RAISING KANE rated in the second flight and drifted out into the first turn then settled before splitting horses into the stretch and rallied

late but just missed. UP TO NO GOOD was allowed to settle early then waited into the turn before making a rail bid and was gaining late for show. NATIONAL ECLIPSE rated in the middle of the pack early before being carried out by RAISING KANE into the first turn then settled then angled eight wide at the 1/4 pole and closed willingly. COMPANY YOU KEEP got shut off and steadied into the first turn when FAST SOLUTION crossed over then rated in the second flight before being ridden along to contend on the second turn and made a three wide bid but was outfinished. VINO COURAGIO settled early along the inside then made a rail rally on the second turn, making a bid into the stretch but faltered late.
