COMMANDED broke outwardly and bumped a foe at the start, tracked from the three path, tipped outside of the top trio entering upper stretch, rallied to reel in the leader in the final furlong and drew clear. TIZNTSHELOVELY bobbled at the start, showed the way while tucking to the inside into the turn, shook free of an outer pair of pressers entering the lane, but was caught by an outer challenger in the final furlong, proved no match for that one yet was second best.

BENTORNATO vied along the inside before backing off to stalk an outer SKELLY down the backstretch, tipped to the four path to take aim outside of that one at the five sixteenths pole, bid while floating to the five path entering the lane, forged an advantage while changing brushes at the three sixteenths pole and drove clear. HERE MI SONG pursued from midpack two wide and between horses, then rallied to reach place at the wire. SKELLY rushed forward, set a clear pace in the three to four path around the turn, got collared by an outer bidder entering the lane, traded brushes with that one while getting headed in upper stretch, yielded through the final furlong and got nailed for place. ROLL ON BIG JOE tracked along the inside, chased through the lane and lacked progress. DURANTE broke outwardly and had a hind heel clipped by an outer rival at the start, stalked in the four path and failed to threaten. AJAAYB pursued from midpack in the five to six path and gave way. BANJO CHRIS was bumped by an inner rival and clipped heels subtly at the start, trailed in the three path and made little impact. LITTLE NI broke slowly, raced off of the pace in the two path and got outrun.

SUBITO prompted two wide, forged an advantage entering the lane, drove clear in midstretch and lasted from an inner challenger at the wire. NU WHAT'S NEW bumped with an inner rival at the start, lacked speed in the three to five path, shifted inwardly while rallying into upper stretch, surged to bid inside of the leader nearing the wire but missed. THE EXODUS TWIST transferred contact from an inner rival to an outer foe leaving the gate, stalked along the inside, chased in teh three to four path in upper stretch, stayed on while getting outkicked by an inner rival at the sixteenth pole and reclaimed show at the wire. GOOD MOJO set the pace inside of the eventual winner, got headed entering the lane, kept on into the final sixteenth but yielded between horses late.

HITCHCOCK was bumped between horses at the start, lacked speed in the three to four path, shifted out to the eight path in midstretch and moved up belatedly. CRAZY DIAMOND tracked two wide and between horses, then ran on mildly among foes in the five path. BARKER bumped an outer foe at the start, trailed into the turn, advanced two wide and between horse into the lane and improved. BOB MO stalked three wide, but faded in the five to six path in upper stretcch. EN FUEGO checked between horses at the five furlong pole, pursued from midpack four wide, floated to the six to seven path in upper stretch and faded. EMPIRE RANCH lacked speed along the inside and never got involved. NUANCED pursued near the inside and tired. IFYOUNEEDMECALLME broke a step slow, raced off of the pace in the three path and tired.
