INTERLOCK EMPIRE laid off of the pace in the three path, shifted out to the five path and between horses entering the lane, rallied to bid in upper stretch, forged an advantage passing the furlong grounds and drove clear. BATTLEOFLEXINGTON lacked speed in the four path, progressed while fanning to the six path into the lane, ran on to issue a bid and edged place while chasing an inner clearing rival home. SCHIFTY'S HALOID tracked along the inside, then from the two path around the far turn, got outkicked by an outer pair while aiming to split rivals leaving upper stretch, then stayed on to re-gain show. TEJAS tracked two wide, then from the three path around the far turn, ranged up to bid in upper stretch, vied between horses into the final furlong but yielded late. TRULY LEGIT stalked outside of the leader and from the three to two path, bid two wide at the three furlong pole, led turning for home, dug in to brace for outer challenges in upper stretch but gave way in the final furlong. UTOPIAN stalked three to two wide, chased the clear leader in upper stretch, sustained his charge to range up to that tiring rival in the final sixteenth and edged past. POPPA ECHO broke outwardly and bothered outer rivals at the start, led two wide before moving to the inside nearing the turn, led uncontested around the bend, maintained a clear advantage through midstretch, but was collared by an outer bidder while tiring in the final sixteenth and gave in late. FLICK steadied when put to tight quarters between horses at the five furlong pole, raced off of the pace along the inside, moved to the three path around the turn, swung to the five path entering the lane, ran on while hanging on his left lead to gain show leaving the furlong grounds, but was bested by an inner bidder in the final sixteenth. MIDNIGHT VENGEANCE tracked two wide, chased around the turn, pursued in the three path in upper stretch and stayed on one paced among rivals. YES IT TIZ pursued from midpack in the two path and behind foes around the first turn, ranged up outside of the leaders to bid in the five path at the five sixteenths pole, sparred with an inner NECESSITY into the lane, leaned in and bumped her counterpart multiple times approaching the furlong grounds, detached while wrestling an advantage leaving that station, then took bumps from her counterpart while battling in the final sixteenth and prevailed. NECESSITY tracked along the inside, slipped through to bid inside of the leaders at the five sixteenths pole, dueled with an outer YES IT TIZ into the lane, took bumps while battling into midstretch, came out and returned the favor while gamely fighting on in the final furlong but was bested. LOOKSTER tracked three wide, bid in the four path around the far turn, but got outkicked by a challenger on either side leaving the five sixteenths pole, proved no match for the top pair in upper stretch and was best of the rest. QUIETLY trailed in the three path, improved in the five path around the far turn, swung out to the seven to eight path in upper stretch and moved up. SHE'S A SWEDE stalked two wide and between horses, prompted in the three path and among foes around the far turn but gave way with five sixteenths to go. ENSORCELL raced off of the pace two wide and between horses, then in the four path around the far turn, got headed between bidders at the five sixteenths pole, drifted out while giving way into the lane and weakened between horses. LADY BLAKE raced off of the pace three wide, then faded in the two path around the far turn. SARAH'S DREAM laid off of the pace along the inside, trailed around the far turn, entered the lane in the four path and made little impact. THE RIDER OF NECESSITY CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST YES IT TIZ ALLEGING INTEREFERENCE THROUGH THE STRETCH.

FOLLOWING THE OBJECTION, AS WELL AS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE SAME MATTER, NO CHANGE WAS MADE TO THE ORIGINAL ORDER OF FINISH.

GOLDEN IRISH set a clear pace in hand around the turn, then widened through the final furlong under a drive. KENTUCKY SMOKESHOW raced forwardly along the inside, stalked the well traveling leader from the two path around the turn, had aim entering the lane, but proved no match and held place. MOON OVER CHOCTAW pursued from midpack along the inside, claimed place from outer rivals at the five sixteenths pole and chased thereafter. MOM'S CHEESECAKE laid off of the pace two wide, swung out to the six path entering the lane and ran on willingly to reach a dead-heat for fourth. CERVARO DELLA SALA (GB) broke a step slow, tracked in the five path, stayed on one paced while hanging on his left lead through midstretch, then got caught to share fourth at the wire. GIVE HER ANOTHER pursued along the inside and lacked a bid. FEASIBLE chased forwardly in the three path and between horses then gave way. MOMBAYLA raced at the rear in the three path and failed to factor. THEPRINCESSFACTOR leaned outwardly at the start, lacked speed in teh four path, fanned out to the seven path into upper stretch and made little impact. THESTRAL broke poorly and spotted the rest many lengths at the start, saved ground well back to no avail. ROYALEWITHCHEESE chased forwardly in the four path and between horses then weakened.
