NAVAJO WARRIOR broke half a step slow, laid off of the pace in teh four path, crept closer in the five path turning for home, sustained gradual progress to bid outside of the leader at the sixteenth pole and drove past while attempting to lug in. HOP SING vied for the lead with an outer rival, backed off to stalk with nine sixteenths to go, tipped to reengage two wide, rebid at the three furlong pole, vied and forged and advantage entering the lane, held sway into the final furlong, but was collared by an outer challenger at the sixteenth pole, got bested and held place. COALMOON broke a step slow, trailed in the two path, took the far turn in the four path before swinging out to the six to seven path into upper stretch and rallied but needed more to reach place late. FORT NELSON vied two wide, led down the backstretch, then along the inside into and around the far turn, but got headed entering the lane, kept on through midstretch and yielded late. FIRST PLAYER checked among foes into the first turn, raced off of the pace while tucking to the inside around that bend, moved to the three path into the far turn, entered the lane in the five path, then ran on belatedly. MAXIMUM PROMISE tracked two wide and between horses, was roused closer three wide around the far turn to attempt a bid turning for home, but failed to sustain his challenge while chasing four wide and between horses in upper stretch, then gradually gave way. CHILLAX pursued from midpack along the inside, tipped two wide turning for home, gained between horses entering the lane, took aim outside of the new leader in upper stretch, bid at the furlong grounds and kicked clear. UP COUNTRY bumped with an inner rival at the start, pressed the leader from the three path, bid turning for home, led into the lane, but was caught by an outer bidder at the furlong grounds and held place. MONEY MAN broke a step slow, trailed along the inside, gained in the two to three path turning for home before fanning out to the seven path into the lane, and rallied willingly. CRISIS MANAGER stalked from the four path, chased around the far turn, got outkicked between rivals while floating to the six path into the lane, drifted inwardly and stayed on. SIXTYSEVEN MUSTANG brushed with an inner rival at the start, tracked two wide and between horses, chased in the three path around the far turn, spun into the lane in the five path and lacked progress among foes. SHALLUS brushed with an outer rival at the start, then saved ground off of the pace to no avail. BISOU broke a step slow, lacked speed in the two path and improved position. VOULEZVOUS bumped with an outer rival at the start,

tracked three wide then in tired in the four path around the far turn. WOODSON showed the way in the two path, got headed by an outer bidder entering the lane and stopped. MY BOY ROCKET brushed with an inner foe leaving the gate, raced off of the pace in the three path and was done early. MONOPOLI broke a step sow and brushed with an outer foe at the start, then made little impact from the three path. MATINEE IDOL stalked along the inside, chased around the far turn and weakened.
