FAIRE PLAISIR pursued from midpack two wide and between horses, shifted out to the six path entering the lane, ran on to claim place in upper stretch, battled with an inner persistent rival for that position through the final furlong and held. TRUSTY TROUTMAN tracked three wide, bid turning for home, but got outkicked entering the lane, fought on to battle for place with an outer foe through the final furlong but was denied. ASIAN MATRIARCH stalked outside of the leader into the backstretch, bid between foes around the far turn, got outkicked entering the lane and gave way. MALIBU SMART set a clear pace, got headed inside of a trio of foes entering the lane and faded. VINO TIEMPO trailed two wide, tucked to the inside into the lane, lacked room to slip inside of foes into the final furlong and failed to factor. SUNSET BEAUTY was off a bit awkwardly and a step slow, lacked speed along the inside and made little impact. SPYING tracked along the inside and faded turning for home.
