TROUBLE TIME broke slowly, tracked three wide into the turn, took light contact from an inner rival entering the lane before taking aim outside of the newly clear leader and from the five path in upper stretch, bid while getting floated wider into the final furlong and drove clear. D BIGALOW pressed two wide, vied around the turn, forged an advantage turning for home, inched clear in the three to four path in upper stretch as an outer TROUBLE TIME took aim, but drifted out while getting collared by that one passing the furlong grounds, proved no match shortly after and held place. SHELLAC tugged close up along the inside early on, settled into stalking stride and pursued from the two path around the turn, brushed an outer foe entering the lane, took aim inside of the newly clear leader in upper stretch, but lacked the needed kick to offer a bid, ran on but was denied place. GAME DAY lagged behind in the two path then moved up. PROUDLY HAILED (GB) drifted outwardly after breaking slow, pursued in the five to four path and yielded. SHOT GUN SHACK showed the way early on, vied with an outer rival around the turn, got headed passing the five sixteenths pole and weakened.

TABLE FLIRT laid off of the pace two wide, then in the three path around the far turn, spilt foes three wide to issue a bid in upper stretch, drew clear at the furlong grounds and held from an outer challenger late. GOLDEN SUNSHINE settled along the inside, then in the two path around the far turn, swung out five wide into upper stretch, sparked progress after changing leads nearing midstretch, rallied to offer a late challenge outside of the leader but came up short. NEXT UP pursued from midpack in the two path, then along the inside into the far steadied, steadied at the three furlong pole, paused behind rivals after moving to the three path in upper stretch, forged between rivals to offer a bid for place at the furlong grounds, but got outkicked and was best of the rest. STANDOUTSENSATION pressed the leader from the three path, vied passing the five furlong pole, led in the two path rounding the far turn, met an outer challenge turning for home, repelled that rival and drove clear in upper stretch then held sway through the final furlong. PIGALLE brushed with an inner rival passing the wire for the first time, set the pace inside of the eventual winner, got headed by that one into the far turn and weakened approaching the lane. EVERLAND laid close up two wide and between horses, tracked along the inside down the backstretch, but weakened around the far turn. LEGADEMA bumped an inner rival leaving the gate, was hustled briefly before being brushed and forced to steady hard between rivals passing the wire for the first time, raced well back along the inside and got outrun.

MYSTIK DAN came in at the start, tracked along the inside, awaited racing room turning for home, was blocked in the three path while lacking room to split rivals in upper stretch, forged through cramped quarters among foes into the final furlong, sustained a charge and ran on to bid inside of the leader at the sixteenth pole, then drove past late. DISARM settled off of the pace in the two path, progressed four wide around the far turn to bid turning for home, vied floating to the five path into the lane, forged an advantage at the three sixteenths pole, shifted inwardly and across rivals' paths entering the final furlong, but was collared by an inner foe at the sixteenth pole and got bested. BANISHING tracked three wide, bid around the far turn, vied in the four aath and between horses into the lane, got headed by his outer counterpart in upper stretch, then steadied when put to tight quarters between foes by that one at the furlong grounds, recovered and kept on to be best of the rest. HIT SHOW was antsy in the starting gate, then broke a step slow, laid well back two wide, took the far turn in the three path, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch and stayed on. PRINCE OF POWER was floated inwardly by an outer foe at the start, pressed two wide, vied between horses turning for home, but got outkicked by outer rivals in upper stretch and gave way after being floated in at the furlong grounds. RATTLE N ROLL broke a beat slow and took back as an outer rival shifted into his path at the start, trailed along the inside, then in the two path around the far turn and made little impact. WILLY D'S set the pace along the inside, vied with an outer rival into the far turn, got headed by a trio of outer bidders at the five sixteenths pole, steadied when brushed at the furlong grounds and weakened.

REVEL TOAST prompted along the inside before backing off to stalk outside of the leader into the turn, ranged up quickly to assume command at the five sixteenths pole, kicked clear into upper stretch and held way under a drive. SWAY HOUSE pursued from midpack in the two path, moved forward between horses at the three furlong pole, claimed place while leaning to the four path into the lane and ran on. SMOKIN HOT STUFF bobbled a bit at the start, laid off of the pace along the inside, swung out to the six path in upper stretch and rallied willingly. FROSTY FOR EVER pursued from midpack in the four path, chased in the five path into the lane, got outkicked by an outer foe in midstretch, dueled for fourth with an inner foe through the final sixteenth and prevailed. NANZIG led two wide, then along the inside into the turn, got overhauled by an outer bidder at the five sixteenths pole, gave way in upper stretch, dueled for fourth with an outer foe in the final sixteenth but got bested. SISTER WIFE was floated outwardly and bobbled slightly at the start, lacked speed in the three path then improved. FIREBIRD SUITE broke outwardly and steadied back at the start, raced off of the pace two wide, swung out to the seven path into the lane and made little impact. TACTICAL COMMAND bumped with an outer foe leaving the gate, trailed along the inside and failed to factor. JUSTIFIABLE STEEL tracked along the inside, chased around the turn and faded. LOLLY POPPIN bumped with an inner foe at the start, tracked in the three path, chased

between horses turning for home and faded entering the lane.
