LIFE OF JOY tracked three wide, bid outside of the leader turning for home, exchanged light brushes while dueling in upper stretch, wrestled an advantage then drove clear late. THE GRUMPY RABBIT set the pace along the inside, met the eventual winner's challenge turning for home, dug in and dueled while exchanging light brushes in upper stretch, battled gamely into the final sixteenth but was bested. GO TO GIRL leaned outwardly at the start, settled off of the pace three wide, advanced around the far turn, took aim outside of the embattled leading pair from the four path entering the lane, but proved no match for those rivals and managed show. AMERICATHEGREAT laid off of the pace in the two path, crept closer between rivals around the far turn, but moved to the inside entering the lane and flattened out. TEARIN'UP MY HEART tracked along the inside, but faded rounding the far turn, shifted out into upper stretch and failed to factor. JOSIE JOE broke outwardly, stalked two wide and between horses, but faded rounding the far turn.
