BEACH BUNNY set the pace inside of a pair of vying rivals into the turn, inched ahead of her only remaining challenge in upper stretch and maintained her narrow margin through the final furlong. MINK STOLE propped at the start and was off a beat slow, rushed forward to vie two wide and between rivals with nine sixteenths to go, sparred with her inner counterpart while drifting to the three path into the lane, failed to keep even terms and lugged in subtly while still pressing in upper stretch, then shied from a right handed crop at the sixteenth pole, did so again nearing the wire and was kept at bay. STARCOURT laid off of the pace two wide and between horses, advanced to gain show in upper stretch and held that position from an inner chaser. AVALON GIRL boke a step slow, laid off of the pace along the inside, trailed turning for home, improved inside of tiring rivals while hanging on her left lead in midstretch, changed over soon after but needed more to bid for show. INVENTING ANNA laid off of the pace in the four to five path and failed to factor. MATERIAL WITNESS prompted three deep into the turn, but faded whlie entering the lane in the four path and weakened between horses in upper stretch.

AMERICAN CITY leaned in and bumped a rival at the start, advanced inside of foes leaving the six furlong pole, loomed a danger stalking from the pocket just behind the leaders around the turn, slipped thru a narrow rail seem and brushed a rival while bidding entering the lane, led narrowly from an outer co-bidder leaving the three sixteenths pole, inched free in the final furlong then held late. DOWN THE ISLANDS stalked outside of the top pair and from the four path, came under a drive approaching the five sixteenths pole, bid along with an inner rival entering the lane, lugged inwardly while hanging on his left lead and surpassing the early leaders at the three sixteenths pole, vied with the aforementioned rail bidder leaving the three sixteenths pole, maintained pressure while changing to his right lead at the furlong grounds, kept on well to sustain his bid late but was denied. NOBLE REIGN broke a bit outwardly at the start., trailed along the inside before advancing in the three to four path into the turn, tipped to the five path into upper stretch, the ran on while hanging on his left lead to edge show. MORALLY vied for the lead with an inner rival while kept in the three path around the turn, sparred three wide and between horses entering the lane before being outkicked by bidders on either side in upper stretch, and gave way. BEGFORFORGIVENESS hopped at the start and was off slow, pursued from midpack tucking down to the two path into the turn, and improved position. BEST DRESSED MAN broke a touch outwardly, led narrowly from an outer vying rival while a path off of the inner rail around the turn, got brushed by a rail bidder entering the lane and weakened in upper stretch. FINANCIAL WHIZ took contact from an outer rival at the start, then saved ground off of the pace to no avail. SUPER SMOOTH chased from midpack in the four path and between horses, but weakened with a half mile to go and was done early. VSOP broke out and brushed the gate at the start, dropped back to the rear in the five to four path into the turn, weakened turning for home, was eased through the lane, jogged to the wire and walked off.

ROWDY RIOT prompted four to three deep down the backstretch, vied with only a single inner rival while turning for home in the three path, gained an advantage in upper stretch, drove clear in midstretch and held from a late bidder. TOP GUN ROCKET was off a step slow and slow into stride, lagged behind early on, saved ground advancing turning for home, swung out to the seven path in upper stretch, rallied with a good late kick but ran out of ground to reel in the leader. I'M MCDREAMY vied two wide and between horses, then just with his outer counterpart while turning for home in the two path, but was bested by that one in upper stretch and yielded. HOP SING tracked along the inside, was roused to the three to four path in pursuit around the turn and gave way. MOMENTUM FILES pressed three wide and between horses early on, but faded approaching the half mile pole and failed to mount a rally. INTO PLEASURE vied for the lead with an outer pair approaching the turn, failed to sustain pressure and chased with three furlongs to go, then weakened through the lane.

DREAMING OF MO tracked along the inside, loomed a danger with run behind the leaders around the far turn, bid up a vacated rail while well in hand entering the lane, kicked clear in upper stretch, drew off under mild urging and was put to wraps with a sixteenth to go. SANCTIFY got a bit antsy before hopping slightly and breaking a beat slow at the start, laid off of the pace in the three path, closed in on the main group turning for home, fanned out to the five path entering the lane and willingly sustained progress to gain place at the furlong grounds. SCHOOL DANCE tracked three wide and from the four path, pursued in range around the far turn, got outkicked by an inner rival entering the lane before being outkicked by an outer rival in upper stretch, then kept on mildly to re-edge show late. MOVIN' ON UP brushed with an inner rival at the start, set the pace in the two path, came under coaxing while showing the way around the far turn, but offered little resistance to an inner challenge entering upper stretch and gave way. EMBRACE ME brushed with an outer foe leaving the gate, trailed along the inside, lagged behind down the backstretch and was outrun. HIDDEN CLASS stalked in the three path and between rivals, then weakened turning fo home.

COUNT DRACULA vied two wide, gained advantage in upper stretch, cleared nearing midstretch and held from an outer bidder. MIKEALICIOUS tracked along the inside, pursued from the two path turning for home before tipping outside of the top pair entering the lane, sustained gradual progress to close in on the clear leader in the final furlong, offered a late bid but was denied. BOURBON'S FAULT set the pace inside of a vying rival, got headed by that one in upper stretch, yielded while losing place in midstretch and remained clear of the rest. REDEMPTION TIME stalked three to two wide and between horses, yielded among rivals turning for home, yet regained stride shifting five wide into the lane and ran on while one paced. GAMBLERS TAIL laid off of the pace along the inside, bumped an outer rival while shifting out to the three path into the far turn, took that bend in the four path before fanning six wide into the lane, then failed to menace. HOLLYWOOD ENDING brushed with an inner rival while being put to crowded quarters between horses and forced to steady passing the wire for the first time, trailed in the three to two path, then five wide around the far turn before floating seven wide into the lane, and failed to factor. METALHEAD checked awkwardly when an outer foe shifted across his path early on, tracked four wide, chased three wide around teh far turn, floated back four wide into the lane and weakened. DYNAMIS brushed with an outer rival while forced to check back passing the wire for the first time, laid off of the pace in the two to three path, took contact from an inner rival while being forced to the four path entering the far turn, then faded turning for home.

MISS TIFEYE tracked along the inside, awaited rail room entering the lane, slipped through when it was vacated in upper stretch and drove clear at the furlong grounds. RANCH LIFE checked between horses at the start, trailed in the three path rallied in the four path and between horses into the final furlong, altered course wider at the sixteenth pole yet sustained her charge to gain place at the wire. DINAHS GIRL chased forwardly in the four path, bid entering the lane, vied before getting outkicked by an inner rival nearing the furlong grounds, chased thereafter but got nailed at the wire for place. LOTTA LISSA pursued from midpack in the five path, crept closer turning for home, chased while flopping back to her left lead leaving the furlong grounds and lacked a bid. JOYFUL PURSUIT pursued from the four path, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch and tired. MOR LUCK lacked speed along the inside, shifted out in upper stretch and failed to factor. FREE PASSAGE stalked in the three path, chased before bidding between horses entering the lane, but weakened in upper stretch. LA BUKANA rushed forward to set the pace the pace in the two path, but was headed between horses while taking a bad step passing the three sixteenths pole, faltered late, pulled up passing the wire and was escorted off of the track in an equine ambulance.
