SOUTH BEND TOM dueled for the lead two wide, drew clear nearing the lane and held sway. YOU BELONG HERE was floated out at the start, raced off of the pace in the four to three path, swung out to the five path into upper stretch and ran on for place. BRAVE BLEND dueled for the lead inside of the eventual winner into the turn, gave way nearing the lane, moved out to the three path in upper stretch, kept on to hold place in the final furlong but yielded that position late. IL CAVALLINO leaned outwardly leaving the gate, stalked in the two path, shifted out to the four path in upper stretch, but only managed to chase before getting outkicked for show at the furlong grounds. ATTERSEE hopped at the start and was off slow, swerved outwardly to avoid a pair of foes shortly after, trailed in the five to four path into the turn, fanned out to the six path into the lane before diving to the two path in upper stretch, but failed to factor. LINEBACKER was floated out by an inner foe at the start, raced off of the pace in the three to two path, then tired along the inside through the lane.
