EDDIE M broke a touch outwardly, stalked outside of the top pair, bid three deep turning for home and drove clear in upper stretch. SOARING BIRD stalked along the inside, awaited racing room from the pocket around the turn, managed to slip inside of a foe to gain place leaving the furlong grounds well after the eventual winner kicked clear, then closed in on that one late but was only second best. SUPREMEPLY vied for the lead with an outer rival around the turn, got outkicked by a wider bidder in upper stretch, yielded and lost place leaving the furlong grounds yet held show thereafter. PRINCIPE CARLO vied for the lead two wide, but got outkicked by an outer challenger in upper stretch and gave way. IMPROBABLE STORY lagged behind in the two path and got outrun.

INDY LABEL trailed along the inside, advanced inside of wide foes entering the backstretch, tracked while tipping out to the four path at the three furlong pole, progressed to bid outside of the top pair entering upper stretch and drove clear. HEART HEADED WOMAN stalked two wide, was roused to press the leader from the three path around the far turn, got outkicked by an outer bidder entering upper stretch and regained place soon after. AIR FORCE THUNDER set a clear pace around the first turn, remained in hand in the two path around the far turn, met a pair of outer bids entering upper stretch, proved no match for his widest challenger shortly after and gave way. AMERICAN HONEY tracked along the inside, chased around the far turn and faded. STEPHANIESWARRIOR settled off of the pace three wide, floated to the six path while retreating to trail entering the backstretch, lacked a response to urging with five furlongs to go and was done early. STRATOSPHERIC pursued along the inside early on, shifted out to the four path into the backstretch, chased then faded after getting floated to the five path at the three furlong pole. CAPTIVE HEART broke a step slow, raced off of the pace two wide and between horses, moved to the five path into the backstretch and tired.

GUNS LOADED sped clear early on, bumped his margin turning for home, came under a drive while delaying a lead change until the three sixteenths pole, then held well from an outer pursuer. CAMP HALE jostled an inner rival soon after the start, pursued from midpack in the for path, progressed turning for home to claim place nearing the lane, then chased the clear leader well through the final furlong while pulling away from the rest. AIN'T NO DISCO was jostled between horses while put to crowded quarters and forced to steady back soon after the start, laid well back in the four path into the turn, advanced tipping to the six path into the lane and rallied to gain show at the furlong grounds. GLOBAL QUOTE broke slowly spotting the rest multiple lengths, lagged behind in the four to five path, tipped wider in upper stretch and rallied to gain fourth in the shadow of the wire. BYE BYE MILES was bumped between horses at the start, raced forwardly two wide and between rivals, chased three wide in upper stretch, gained fourth late but was bested nearing the wire. BRODEUR stalked two wide, got outkicked by an outer bidder for place entering the lane and yielded. TEARS IN RAIN lacked speed in the two path, shifted out in upper stretch and moved up. CASTLE RUN broke a step slow, rushed forward along the inside, but steadied behind the leader at the five furlong pole, settled into stalking stride shortly after, but chased around the turn and gave way. T KRAFT leaned into an outer rival at the start, tracked along the inside,

but yielded turning for home and lacked a re-rally. STUDENY brushed the inner stall door upon leaving the gate a step slow, raced off of the pace in the three path and failed to factor between horses. INTO INSPIRATION chased forwardly three wide but faded between horses. SHADOW COAST was jostled between horses, pinched and lost his rider soon after the start, then was gathered by an out rider in the gallop out and walked off.

ECHO LANE pressed two wide, bid around the far turn, drew clear in upper stretch and held late. SUGOI stalked three wide, claimed place and chased the

clear leader in the five path into the final furlong, closed in on that one late but was denied. HARROW trailed along the inside, then in the three to four path around the far turn before swinging to the eight path into the lane, rallied belatedly to gain show in the final sixteenth and closed in on the top pair belatedly. WARRIOR RICHARD laid well back in the three to two path, searched for racing room in the four path entering upper stretch, but tipped in to split foes two wide at the furlong grounds, gained show in the aftermath but was bested by an outer rival in the final sixteenth. GOOD GOVERNANCE (GB) lacked speed in the two to three path, swung to the seven path and between horses in upper stretch and ran on mildly. JOURNEYMAN laid off of the pace in the four path, moved to the six path in upper stretch and stayed on evenly. BIZZEE CHANNEL stalked along the inside, chased in the two to three path in upper stretch and faded. KENTUCKY GHOST pursued from midpack in the three path, shifted to the five path entering the lane, hung on his left lead and yielded between horses. TIDAL FORCES tracked two wide and between horses, chased along the inside around the far turn, shifted out and failed to factor between horses. HUGE BIGLY lacked speed along the inside and made little impact. CADET CORPS saved ground off of the pace, but to no avail. DEVIL'S HARVEST set the pace along the inside, vied with an outer bidder around the far turn, got bested entering the lane and weakened.
