WILDCATJUSTICE pursued from midpack in the three path and between horses into the turn, chased the main group in upper stretch, angled six wide and outside of them into the final furlong and rallied to reel in the leader in the shadow of the wire. SLAM DIEGO tracked in midpack in the four path, got brushed and floated five wide by an inner rival entering the lane, closed in while trading light contact with that one in upper stretch, bid and forged a narrow advantage at the furlong grounds, held into the final sixteenth but was caught by an outer bidder at the wire. YOLO CALLS prompted three deep, vied around the turn, took light contact to his outer hind quarters by an outer bidder at the furlong grounds, fought on between rivals while dueling for show late and narrowly prevailed for that position. TRAFALGAR SHORE prompted two wide and between horses, sparred around the turn, fought on while hanging on his left lead through the final furlong and just missed show. JUMP INTO THE FIRE broke a beat slow, tugged forward inside of rivals down the backstretch, tracked from the two path around the turn, brushed an outer rival while moving four wide into the lane, exchanged light contact with that one while closing in outside of the leaders in upper stretch, brushed an inner foe while bidding between horses at the furlong grounds, battled on into the final sixteenth while hanging on her left lead but yielded late. CACTUS FLOWER broke a step slow, vied for the lead with an outer pair of prompters into and around the turn, kept on as a wider pair of bidders joined the fray in upper stretch, but faded leaving the furlong grounds while hanging on her left lead. INNER HARBOR broke outwardly, lacked speed in the four path and made little impact. BABY GUNDIN bobbled a bit and broke slowly leaving the gate, trailed in the five to six path and got outrun.

HAUNTED FLAME broke a step slow, laid off of the pace in the two path, gained ground in the four path around the turn, fanned to the six path into the lane, gained place before lugging inwardly in midstretch, yet sustained his charge to reel in the leader in time. STORM THE STREETS bumped with an inner rival at the start, prompted three deep, vied in the four path into the turn, gained an advantage with three furlongs to go, assumed command and drew clear turning for home, opened up under a drive in upper stretch, but was put to a mild left handed flagging in the final sixteenth and got nailed by an outer bidder nearing the wire. STUNNING BRUNO chased from midpack along the inside, tipped out and encountered brief traffic in the five path entering the lane, altered out in upper stretch, bid for show at the furlong grounds, brushed with an inner rival while dueling for that position in the late stages and held. GOLDEN ICE tracked in the five path, got outkicked for minor placings by an outer rival in upper stretch, vied for show with a different outer bidder at the furlong grounds, dueled and brushed with that one late but missed show at the wire. MAN OF MISCHIEF laid off of the pace in the four to five path, tucked down to the three path into upper stretch, shifted out to the six path in midstretch and improved up before holding fifth late. 

CAROLINA SMOKESHOW laid off the pace in the four path, bid four deep into the far turn, vied three wide and forged an advantage turning for home, dueled with an inner game counterpart through midstretch, inched free late and held sway. LORD I WONDER broke outwardly, set the pace along the inside, drew clear in upper stretch and held sway on his left lad. GATE TO PARADISE got floated out at the start, tracked four wide, ran on in the five path to claim place at the sixteenth pole and was gaining on the clear leader late. LADY GO GO leaned out at the start, stalked three wide, chased closest to the clearing leader entering the lane, but hung on her left lead and lugged inwardly while losing place at the sixteenth pole. UPON A STAR broke a beat slow, pursued from midpack in the two path, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch, ran on mildly to claim fourth at the sixteenth pole and held that position late. HERE'SYOURTROUBLE bumped with an outer rival at the start, checked shortly after, trailed in the two path, gained ground while tipping out in midstretch and sustained progress to miss fourth at the wire. LEGACY DEFINED tracked along the inside and gave way. KISS ME AGAIN broke outwardly, chased two wide and between horses but faded while hanging on her left lead. CATHCART bumped with an inner rival leaving the gate, laid off of the pace in the three path, shifted out to the six path into the lane and failed to factor. LUNAR SEAS got floated out by an inner rival at the start, lacked speed in the four path and tired.
