TAKE YOUR SEATS (IRE) was reserved early, advanced three wide on the far turn and finished well to be clearly second best. WILMA FLINTSHIRE was allowed to settle early and made a inside move but flattened out while saving the show award. LOVE SHAQ was settled back early, advanced on the far turn and saved ground into the lane but was in tight nearing the furlong marker and missed the show award. AMERICAN WAR HERO chased the pace on the inside and tired. VON HOFF tracked the pace three wide and tired in the lane. FLORIANOPOLIS set the pace early on and then pressed the winner to the mile and a quarter mark and then tired. NORTHERN TICK TOCK was settled back early and had no response and was eased the final furlong.

ROJA REDEMPTION was well placed on the inside and made a decisive inside bid after jump eight and drew off on the far turn and was well clear to prove much the best while being wrapped up the final furlong, easily. KICKING MYSELF (IRE) was reserved early, finished willingly to be clearly second best while no match to the winner. DANTE'S FIRE was allowed to settle early and lacked a serious rally while besting the rest. PAVONI was settled back early and passed the tiring rivals. BENJIS BENEFIT (IRE) stalked the early pace and made a three wide bid to take a short lead but tired on the far turn. FACTOTUM was settled back early and had no response. SELASSIE was allowed to settle early on the outside and tired. FINAL OPPORTUNITY was taken back under a hard hold and eased.

CYBER NINJA was allowed to settle on the inside, moved up into contention after jump seven and made a three wide bid after the ninth jump and shook clear on the turn and then drew out leaving the turn to prove best under a drive. SWORE was allowed to settle early, shuffled back and moved to the outside on the first circuit, then advanced on the far turn under a ride, split rivals leaving the turn and finished well to be clearly second best. CADOGAN PLACE (GB) was reserved early and saved ground on the far turn and was along for the show award on the inside. AWESOME MAN tracked the leaders throughout and was three to four wide on the far turn but weakened ion the final furlong. PHILIP MY DEAR was reserved early, pulled way up on the outside to vie for command at the half mile marker and then vied for command on the outside before tiring. LIGHTUP LIGHTUP showed the way early while clear before being headed and vying for command for a little over a mile and then tired on the backstretch. CARTOGRAPHER was a bit rank early, reserved between rivals and then made a middle move between rivals to be in contention over the seventh fence but tired on the far turn. MISSION MAN chased the pace three wide and stopped and then was eased in the lane. MADE TO BE LUCKY was settled back early and then left the course after the sixth jump.

PRIMED TO GO was three wide into the first turn and unhurried, advanced two wide on the far turn while covered up, tipped out leaving the turn to make a three wide bid, hit the front at the furlong marker and edged clear by the sixteenth peg and then held QUOKKA safe late to prove best, driving. QUOKKA was reserved two wide early, advanced three wide on the far turn, angled in leaving the three sixteenths and was blocked by the furlong marker and angled out for racing room and closed well late. MR FLOWERS stalked the early pace and inched closer on the far turn and made a two wide bid to vie for command leaving the turn, between rivals by the furlong marker but was out-kicked. LOOK TO THE CROSS was settled back early, advanced two to four wide on the far turn and came five wide into the lane and had a mild late rally. NAPTOWN was settled early on the inside, two to three wide on the far turn, angled out in the lane and had a belated rally. COVERT KAT set the pace along the inside while clear, headed leaving the quarter pole and fought on to the furlong marker but faded. THICK AS THIEVES was settled two wide, then moved out midway on the turn and came five wide into the lane but had no rally. TESTED was rated along the inside and cut the corner leaving the turn but weakened in the lane. KORU was rated along two wide and made a mild bid three wide by the quarter pole but weakened in the lane.
