LUCKED IN settled back early to trail, two to three path on the turn, split rivals leaving the quarter pole, closed well to edge clear late to prove best under a drive. SET ABOUT was reserved early, saved ground on the turn and came two wide off the bend and rallied well up the inside but was out-kicked by the winner. PICO PLAT set a fast pace while racing off the rail down the backside, moved to the inside entering the turn while still clear, moved out to the two path by the three eights marker and came three wide by the quarter pole and was sent down, headed by the sixteenth marker and could not go with the top while staying on for the show award. PYROMANIA was off slowly, advanced three wide on the turn, angled out leaving the quarter pole, made a bid to be with in range by the furlong marker but hung late and needed more. ALIGN chased the early pace and was three wide on the turn, made a four wide bid leaving the turn but flattened out in the final furlong. ANDRAS chased the pace along the inside but weakened in the lane. WATERMELON CRUSH was reserved early and two to three wide on the turn and never threatened.

BUTHESPRETTY tracked the pace from between rivals, came two wide off the bend and moved to the inside in the lane to close up the rail to get up late and edge clear under a drive. VERNOR'S JUNCTION set a pressured pace on the inside and then dueled for command by the five sixteenths and then cut the corner leaving the turn and dug in to regain a short lead and came off the rail in the furlong grounds and was caught late while staying on for the place award. COURAGEOUS MISSION was allowed to settle along the rail, cut the corner leaving the turn and advanced in the lane but had to angle out late for racing room and then was gaining late. CHUCKY OUR LAW was settled early and raced two wide on the turn, angled out wide when straightened and had a mild late rally on the far outside. LOCOMOTIVE pressed the pace two wide and made a three wide bid to vie for command but faded late. COLONEL TULLY was well placed on the inside and then moved off the inside and came four wide into the lane but weakened. PADDY O'GUIRRE was outrun early and far back early and then showed some late foot while never threatening. REBEL'S MEMORY tracked the pace from the outside and stopped.

SUN CROSS was allowed to settle along the inside, saved ground on the turn and finished well up the rail to be second best. BUZZAWAY was taken back early to trail, advanced on the outside down the backside, three wide on the far turn, shifted in by the three sixteenths and then moved out and had a mild late rally to gain the show award. QUADRA set the pace along the inside and then was pressured nearing the nine sixteenths and onto the far turn, shook clear leaving the bend but came up empty in the final furlong. MILA CANDY prompted the leader two wide and then moved up to press that rival and came three wide into the lane but weakened. GOLD DART was rated along in the two path but fell back on the far turn and tired.

CAVIAR BREAKFAST vied for the lead on the inside and then relented nearing the quarter pole and moved off the inside to come three wide into the lane and came again to run on to the got show award bob. BE TOGETHER was reserved early and advanced two wide on the far turn and eased out to be four to five wide off the bend, moved in and rallied towards the inside just missing the show award. STENTS AND STATINS (GB) was settled back early, advanced two wide on the far turn and finished well on the inside but needed more. CRAWFORD was well placed along the inside, eased out on the turn and came four wide into the lane and loomed by the furlong marker but had no late kick.
