J J GREY prompted the pace two wide and then was in tight leaving the half mile marker and shuffled back between rivals on the turn, moved out to make a four wide bid leaving the turn and drew clear in the final sixteenth to prove best under a drive. NO HAY DOS was allowed to settle early, made a four wide move on the far turn to take over leaving the turn to be clear by the furlong marker but could not go with the winner in the final sixteenth while clearly second best. BEYBE BETO was well placed along the inside, boxed on the inside leaving the half mile marker and saved ground on the far turn, swung out four wide leaving the turn and ran on to best the rest. UNDERTAKER stalked the pace and made a three wide bid on the far turn to gain a short lead but weakened in the drive. MORE THAN CUTE was reserved early, advanced on the inside entering the far turn and moved out to come five wide into the lane but was bumped and shut off in between rivals and then recovered and moved to the inside and improved. COLT FORTY SEVEN chased the early pace two to three wide, came six wide into the lane and lugged in badly bumping a rival and then lacked rally. THE BIG BEN was keen early and set the pace on the inside and gave way on the far turn. COCO NO LOCO was reserved early, raced four to five wide on the far turn and swung out eight wide leaving the

turn and had no rally. BOSS MODE was reserved early and failed to menace. ROCKY LAGOON broke in and bumped a rival and then made a four wide middle move on the backside to press the pace on the far turn but tired. DONUT DUST was bumped at the start and raced on the inside early and was not a factor. GOOD NIGHT AMERICA was pin balled at the break and far back early and had no response. STEWARDS INQUIRY into the running into the lane but after reviewing the replays the race was left as is.

MOSE PERFECT was bumped leaving the seven furlong marker, then prompted the pace and went up two wide to duel for command on the turn, gained short lead leaving the turn and was bumped slightly inside the sixteenth marker and maintained a safe margin to prove best under a drive. PASSIONED set the pace on the inside and then dueled for the lead on the inside, jumped a shadow nearing the upper stretch and then fought on gamely in the lane and jumped a shadow again by the sixteenth marker and bumped the winner late but had to settle for second best. MR JEFFERSON bumped the winner by the seven furlong marker and stalked the pace three wide and fell back on the turn and came four wide by the quarter pole and weakened. UNION FLEET chased the early pace and tired.

SOUPER UPGRADE was allowed to settle early, moved out to make a four to five wide move on the turn and came five to six wide off the bend and hit the front leaving the furlong marker and drew off to prove much the best. NAVAL HOSPITAL tracked the pace and was two wide on the turn behind the vying leaders, swung out four wide leaving the turn to make a bid and vied for command between rivals by the furlong marker and kept on to be second best. READY TO ROCKNROLL chased the pace along the inside and checked by the three eighths marker, angled out leaving the turn and then angled out farther for racing room and was along for the show award. ALL INCLUDED rushed up towards the outside and vied for the lead in between rivals on the turn and continued on to the furlong marker but faded, losing the show award late. MAGIC MARK pressed the early pace on the inside and then steadied on the inside approaching the half mile marker, then continued on the inside and was blocked by the quarter pole to the furlong marker and then had no late kick, brutal trip. INNOCENT NYGHT set a pressured pace early two wide, then vied for the lead on the inside on the turn to the furlong marker and weakened. PRINCESS CHLOE was allowed to settle early and two to three path on the turn and had no rally. CARTOON CITY was off a step slow on the inside, two to three path on the turn and came four wide into the lane and moved in leaving the three sixteenths but lacked a rally. WHISKEY BREW was reserved early, three wide on the turn and came five wide into the lane and lacked a rally. JESS'S VISION was reserved early and saved ground on the turn and never threatened. SMOKEY RAIN rushed up on the outside to press the early pace and then vie for command three wide on the turn but weakened. RIVER RABBIT was off slowly and never factored.
