NATHAN DETROIT was reserved early towards the outside, moved in to the two path on the second circuit and made a three wide move on the far turn and closed the gap fast and took over leaving the turn and drew off to prove much the best while being ridden out, pulled up bad and was loaded onto the Equine Ambulance for further evaluation. LOVE SHAQ was allowed to settle on the inside and advanced two wide on the far turn and ran on in the final sixteenth to gain the place award to be second best. MARYLAND MOON was settled back early and advanced on the outside on the far turn and was up for the show award late. TAKE YOUR SEATS (IRE) was sent to the front after the first jump and set the pace on the inside while clear, drew off after the last fence but was headed leaving the turn and offered no resistance for that rival, but did fight on the the sixteenth marker but tired late and lost the show award on the wire. CARNANE (IRE) passed the tiring rivals. MOSEY was slow into stride while fighting with the rider on the first turn, then found best stride late on the second circuit. KING OF TSAVO (GB) was settled and found the inside and tired. REJECTION HURTS was settled on the outside and tired. FINGAL chased the pace after the first fence and was on the inside on the far turn and stopped. AMERICAN WAR HERO pulled up after the jump six and walked off.

IN EFFECT was allowed to settle early, bobbled over jump five and then made a inside run on the far turn to be in contention by the furlong marker and ran on while no match for the winner but clearly second best. PERFECT REEL (IRE) chased the leader for the first circuit, made a bid over the eighth fence and gained a short lead leaving the last fence, then was headed leaving the furlong marker and faded while staying on for the show award. AWESOME MAN was reserved on the inside under a good hold, made a four wide run on the far turn but flattened out in the final furlong while besting the rest. GRATIA PRINCE chased the pace on the inside and made a bid after the last jump to be in contention on the far turn but tired in the final furlong. OCEAN CITY was settled back early and jumped poorly while being no factor. SPEAK UNITY was reserved on the inside and failed to menace. BASELINE BEATER showed the way early and opened up a big lead and was headed after the eighth jump and then gave way on the far turn.

AVAKATE (IRE) set the pace while clear and was well handled throughout, drew off on the far turn and then widened the margin in the lane under very little hand urging to dominate. MADAKET'S ARROW was taken back early to trail on the first circuit, made a bid between rivals over the eighth fence and then was bumped between rivals over the ninth and then moved to the inside on the turn and cut the corner leaving the turn and was up for the place award in the final furlong while no match to the winner. ANADOR (FR) chased the pace along the inside and then was bumped over the ninth fence, advanced on the far turn and came two to three wide off the bend and proved to be no match for the winner while being out-kicked for the place award. LOVE SAGA was settled early two wide, then advanced on the inside on the far turn and was blocked leaving the turn and had to wait, moved in when straightened for racing room but flattened out and needed more late. LOVE FOREVERAFTER chased the winner from the outside and moved closer nearing the finish line after the first circuit, jumped poorly over the last two jumps bumping a rival and tired. BOLD LOOK was settled on the inside and tired. STEWARDS INQUIRY concerning the last two jumps but after reviewing the replays the race was left as is.
