CURLY LARRY AND MO was away alertly and showed the way while clear on the inside and was well handled throughout and kicked clear leaving the turn and sent down nearing the furlong marker and held well to remain clear under a drive. NEON NIGHTS stalked the pace two wide and came three wide into the lane and ran on willingly but could not gain on the winner while holding on to the place award. CAP'N DUSTY was off a step slow and settled along the inside, saved ground on the far turn and swung out five wide leaving the turn and finished well to just miss the place award. DEADPAN tracked the pace along the inside and saved ground on the far turn and angled out by the furlong marker but had no late kick. UPTOWN TAPPIN was reserved on the inside, then was on the inside to the two path on the far turn but lacked a serious rally. DR. HYDE was settled two to three wide and came four wide into the lane and faded in the drive.

NOTHING PERSONAL tracked the early pace and was three wide on the turn, ranged up to make a three wide bid leaving the turn and drew off smartly to prove much the best while being kept to left handed crop pressure, sharp. ANTRAX rushed up the inside and duel for the lead and then battled on thru the turn and proved to be no match for the winner while winning the battle for the place award. SHARONS BEACH duelled for the lead two wide and then gained a short lead on the turn and was in between rivals leaving the turn and proved to be no match for the winner while being out-kicked for the place award. KID CHARLEMAGNE tracked the early pace from the outside and then chased the pace three wide entering the turn and weakened. VERY CONNECTED raced on the inside early and was climbing a bit and dropped back, then advanced on the inside on the turn before checking by the three eighths marker, moved out to be three to four wide off the bend and improved. GREEN LIGHT DAY was settled early and three to four wide on the turn and tired. SWERVE was allowed to settle and saved ground on the turn and tired. STREET STYLE was off slowly and trailed early and was on the inside to the two path on the turn and never factored. WAR WORLD ROCKS was settled early and was two wide on the turn and dropped back. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

PUBLIC DEFENDER was well rated three to two wide early, inched closer nearing the quarter pole and came three wide off the bend and made a two wide bid to hit the front nearing the furlong marker and drew off impressively to prove much the best, driving. KING'S RIVER was taken back early on the inside, moved out to be two to three wide on the far turn and came four wide into the lane and finished well to gain the place award while no match to the winner. OPERATION TORCH set a pressured fast pace along the inside and shook clear leaving the three eighths marker but was headed leaving the three sixteenths and weakened in the final furlong while staying on for the show award. SENDERO was reserved early and made a three wide run on the far turn to be in contention off the bend but flattened out. VINTAGE YEAR was reserved early and saved ground on the far turn moved off the inside leaving the turn but was blocked and moved back to the rail to get thru but had no late kick. BAYTOWN BRUISER was four wide into the first turn, settled on the outside and was three wide but tired. COCKTAILS AT NOON was settled along the inside and weakened. FALFURRIAS pressed the pace two wide and stopped in the final quarter of a mile.

MAGIC PATHWAY set the pace from the inside and was soon clear from the pack, was headed nearing the quarter pole and came on again and drew clear in the stretch in the two path to prove best. OUTRUNNER was hard held early on and tracked the pace from the inside, had a late rally but was short of the winner while being clearly second best. ENGLISH LAW was bumped at the start and tracked the pace setter, advanced on the turn and pressed the lead nearing the quarter pole but weakened and held the show award. PARACLETE was settled mid pack and came three wide on the turn and five wide into the upper stretch but needed more. SOLEIL VOLANT was bumped around from both sides soon after leaving the gate and clipped heels before the first turn and continued on to the inside while well off the pace, came about two to three wide on the turn and swung seven wide into the upper stretch and had a mild late gain. HANDSOME PANTS was slightly taken up on the first turn and settled back on the inside, came about four wide into the upper stretch and angled in late but weakened. RUNNER EYES was reluctant loading into the gate, bumped at the start from the outside and clipped heels with a rival from behind and was rank before the first turn, then settled in the two path mid-pack, coming around the turn shifted to the out to the three to four path and came about six wide into the upper stretch and faded. JUS TOO FLY was settled back and came about three to four wide on the turn and swung eight wide into the upper stretch but had no kick. CRAB DADDY was jostled at the break and had to steady slightly, shifted into the inside rail while trailing the field and was no factor. STEWARDS INQUIRY after video review there was no changes.
