ASHWEEEE got away a step slowly then moved up to contend behind horses, lacked room nearing the 1/2 pole then altered to circle while seven wide and grabbed the lead into the stretch, clearing late but was caught on the wire. KINDA KRAZY showed no speed early then ranged up while six wide nearing the 1/4 pole and made a bid into the stretch but it wasn't enough. LADSFIRSTLOVE rated in the second flight early then made a steady advance while four wide but flattened out in the stretch. MAHIRA was fractious in the starting gate then raced close up while along the inside, pressing the leaders, contended to the lane but faltered late. SCAT moved up shortly after the start and assumed command while being pushed along, led to the turn but starting fading at the 3/8 pole. LADY LYLA was fractious in the starting gate then broke sharply and pressed the pace while three wide but came up empty in the lane.

IRISH NUNSENSE settled early off the pace before taking up behind horses at the 7/8 pole then had a rail trip along the backstretch before angling out into the lane and rallying, leading late but was outfinished on the wire. ZENCAT rated in the second flight early while under a tight hold then battled between horses through the second turn, contended into the lane and held show. PAID VACATION chased the early pace while five wide and under a tight hold through the first turn, then took over the lead on the backstretch and opened up into the second turn before giving way in the stretch. BEAUTIFUL QUALITY showed early speed along the inside and led through the first turn before being headed at the 3/4 pole and ceded the lead then made no rally in the lane. FORGET THE RULES was allowed to settle early and tucked in before being asked while four wide on the second turn but faltered.

GOLDEN FAITH was rushed away from the gate between horses and moved to the early lead, battled through the turn and into the lane and held on for place. DOLCE FAR NIENTE got off a step slowly and tucked in early with a rail trip then angled six wide at the 3/8 pole to make a move before being steadied behind horses at the 3/16 pole then ran on late when clear. X G MAN rated in the middle of the pack early then split horses into the turn before lugging in nearing the 3/8 pole and bothering BOUGIE BRO before racing evenly in the lane. LAWSON'S LEGACY broke sharply and stalked the early pace with a rail trip then was in tight nearing the 3/8 pole and gave way late in the lane. SISU SPIRIT chased the early pace while four wide and keen to go then was getting out on the turn and raced greenly in the stretch. BOUGIE BRO settled early before moving into contention on the turn but steadied behind X G MAN at the 3/8 pole then dropped back before altering course to go six wide but made no rally.

ROOMMATE MARTIN settled just off the pace inside, saved ground on the turn, sought room in upper- to mid-stretch altering out five wide past the furlong marker, was second best. SLIPPIN JIMMY stalked from outside four wide through the turn, ran on evenly. POINT LIAM settled off the pace outside runners, went three wide on the turn, angled seven to eight deep in the stretch, gained late outside.
