MONTOUR broke with the field, was shuffled back soon after when in tight quarters among traffic, raced back into the turn while going greenly, advanced three wide late in the bend, continued to gain, drifted in a bit midstretch, engaged the pace settled late and wore that rival down while kept to pressure. AFTER ALL broke alertly, cleared toward the inside, showed the way into the turn, shrugged off a mild bid from BETTERPARTOFVALOUR exiting the bend, offered brief resistance to the winner late then proved no match, clearly second best. BETTERPARTOFVALOUR off the early pace while racing outside, moved closer three wide late in the turn, flattened out through the lane to finish up best of the rest. STICKY SITUATION forwardly placed while off the inside, continued within striking distance late in the turn, lacked a closing punch. GONE FOR GOOD broke in, was straightened and raced in the second flight inside, fell back while saving ground through the turn, in a bit tight entering the stretch then went evenly through the lane. CLASSY AZUL in mid pack while racing off the inside, had little for the drive. HURRICANE MATTIE hopped at the break to be off slowly, trailed throughout to be always outrun.

THEMIS hesitated at the break to be away slowly, moved outside, advanced to the second flight while four wide through the turn, challenged outside the leaders past the furlong marker and edged clear late under steady handling. LOUVAR broke back, raced in mid pack up the backstretch along the inside, continued to save ground turn, moved out around a tiring rival nearing the furlong grounds, dropped back inside and rallied up the rail to be in time for the place, no threat to the winner. TOOT with early pace inside, shuffled back before a furlong, moved out and raced between rivals in the second flight through the turn, asked along late in the bend, showed some late interest but missed the place in the final strides. TIZ MY STANDARDS broke well, cleared toward the inside, dueled closest to the inside through the turn, held a narrow advantage a furlong out, weakened late when headed by the winner. COMMON SENSE raced back off the pace outside the runner up, idled in traffic turning for home, moved out a bit, clear for the run to the wire by midstretch, finished willingly to improve position while too late to seriously contend. EXTRA SPECIAL moved up to duel off the inside, continued to vie into and through upper stretch, faltered in the final furlong. HURRICANE LYNN in the second flight while three wide and inside the winner into and through the turn, tired in the drive. MIDNIGHT SPIN raced in the second group inside, gave way steadily through the lane.

FLY NOW settled behind the pace along the inside, headed up the second flight into the far turn, tipped out three wide when beginning to move midway on that bend, engaged the leaders three wide turning for home, quickly shook clear in upper straight and maintained a comfortable advantage to the wire while kept to pressure. BOSS LILY lacked speed while racing off the inside, raced between horses in the two path far bend, angled out a bit to be four wide when moving closer exiting the final turn, could do little with the winner through the lane while remaining clear for the runner up spot. BAD BOY BLAZE hesitated at the break to spot the field a couple of lengths, raced back while three wide through the first turn, floated out five wide by the runner up exiting the second while advancing, displayed a mild amount of interest in the run to the wire to report home best of the others. BREWMMASTER lacked speed inside, moved slightly closer in the second turn when still saving ground, moved out slightly when set down for the stretch run, improved position with a modest rally without posing a serious threat. HIGH YIELD HUNK behind the pace off the inside, in the second group between horses while outside the winner into the far turn, failed to go with that one with less than three furlongs remaining, steered out to be five wide into the lane, went evenly in the drive while continuing to lack a significant response. STONE COLD JONES broke well from the outside, relinquished the advantage in the first turn while off the rail, chased the pacesetter up the backstretch and into the far turn, gave way in the drive. RANDY SAID SO took over along the inside before a quarter, set the pace while saving ground, continued to hold the advantage second turn then stopped when headed by the winner, entering the straight.

MOLLY THE GREAT unhurried for six furlongs toward the inside, asked along late in the final turn, steered to the outside to hit a seam in upper stretch under clever handling, late burst down the middle of the course to be up in time. SNOWGLOBE settled off the early pace, waited toward the inside into the far turn, stalled, moved out three wide late in the final turn, set down, rallied and finished well to earn the place while coming in late to tighten up a stalled GOTTA BE DA SHOES. LAZY Y LEGACY asked a bit away from the gate to show the way into the first turn, set a moderate pace along the inside, continued to show the way through the final turn and into the lane, found more when challenged in upper straight and gave ground grudgingly in the late going. LIGHT DE NIGHT prompted the pace while off the inside, crept closer and challenged between horses for an extended drive, stayed on to the finish. GOTTA BE DA SHOES back off the pace and the inside, advanced three wide into contention into the stretch, three deep bid stretch, stalled then steadied late when the winner came in. TRICKER settled back off the pace and the inside, raced four wide through the final turn, lacked a closing punch. BAHAMA

WIND moved outside into the first turn, raced five wide through that bend, continued well wide up the backstretch, five to four wide through the second bend, lacked a closing kick. KISSED BY KARMA dropped inside, raced within striking distance while saving ground in the second turn, had little response when asked for the drive. KNIGHT CHEETAH fell back to trail after the start, never menaced. SWEET LEXI broke out, straightened, prompted the pace for five furlongs, gave way in some traffic second turn, moved to the outside and was eased through the lane, walked off. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE RUN THROUGH DEEP STRETCH, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND.
