HOLY JOANIE set the pace from the inside and swayed in the upper and held clear to prove best. BEYOND QUESTION stalked the pace from the two path and came three wide in the upper and angled out a bit in the deep stretch to find room but needed more to best the winner. DAME'S ROCKET tracked the pace from the inside and was cut off in the upper and slightly checked then weakened and settled for the show award. DIANE LEE raced in the mid-pack three wide and came four wide in the upper but lacked punch. THISISHOWWEDOIT settled mid-pack early on between rivals in the two to three path and steadied entering the turn then came five wide in the upper but needed a bid. VANAKA raced in the mid-pack early from the inside to two path and settled back a bit and made no bid. GRANUAILE was step slow at the break and settled near the back in the four path then swung out seven wide in the upper but was no factor. CLEARLY INISH was off slow at the break and settled off the pace in the two path then tipped out six wide in the upper but had no kick. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND RIDERS OBJECTION IN THE STRETCH BETWEEN DAME'S ROCKET AND HOLY JOANIE. AFTER VIDEO REVIEW THE 6, HOLY JOANIE WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED THIRD.

GO TO BINGO raced in range inside, angled three wide in upper stretch and ran on to be clearly second best. KARMA'S INTHEHOUSE set the pace along the rail, was collared by the winner in upper stretch but kept on well inside to hold the show. MAKE IT QUICK bumped with DYNAFLAME at the start and again nearing the turn, bobbled soon after, rated back inside early on the turn, angled four wide nearing the quarter pole, rallied mildly outside and just missed third. DYNAFLAME bumped with MAKE IT QUICK at the start, bumped with that foe again nearing the turn, chased the pace two wide between rivals and lacked a closing bid. EL JUNIOR was bumped just after the start, raced three wide and never threatened. A. L.'S BOY was off slow and trailed inside.

AMBERIA (IRE) bumped into a rival at the start and tracked the pace from the inside then tipped out three wide in the upper and rallied into the stretch but just missed. BAND ON THE RUN was bumped at the start and settled mid-pack in the two path and shifted to the inside off the bend but just needed more. SUN CROSS bobbled entering the first turn and was checked then was steadied at the top of the turn then settled into stride three to two wide at the back, then angled out six wide into the upper and had a late kick. DREAM OVERTURE settled back early then shifted up to be mid-pack in the three path then came five wide in the upper but flattened out. YAMMY YAMMY BELLA bumped with a rival and settled back in the five path then swung out nine wide in the upper and made a mild gain in the stretch. FULL EXCHANGE bumped into the rail entering the first turn and settled on the inside at the back of the pack then came four wide around the turn and tipped out eight wide into the upper but was no factor. SQUIRRELY pressed the pace from two path for most of the race and weakened nearing the bottom of the turn and came four wide in the upper then faded.
