BAHAMA WIND broke back, moved up to a position in the second flight first turn while angling in in front of the runner up, stalked the pace in the run up the backstretch in the three path, moved closer in the three path final turn, drifted out a bit upper stretch, took over inside the furlong marker, clear late, held the next two safe under firm handling. IMPROBABLE TALE raced in mid pack toward the inside past the wire the first time, steadied and came out suddenly across the winner's heels entering the first turn as that one was steered in, recovered and raced on the outside up the backstretch, asked along late final turn, floated out five wide into the straight, was set down, rallied on the outside and was getting to the victor in the final strides, too late. COMBUSTIBLE MASS off slowly, continued to lack early foot while in the two path, asked for run while three to four wide turning into the straight, also was going well late while between the top two at the wire. SHESA MISCHIEFLADY in the second flight toward the inside first turn, pulled, lacked room in traffic early backstretch along the rail, continued to track inside, lacked room once again when along the inside upper stretch, moved out nearing the furlong grounds and came up empty late. MAHIRA void of early foot, carried out seven wide into the first turn by the runner up, continued back, displayed some mild late interest to improve position, not a serious threat. JANENMIKE broke on top, rank in the early going along the inside, chased backstretch, took over rail far turn, continued to show the way into the stretch, faltered the final furlong. MORGANITE ROSE remained back in failing to threaten. FALINA BLUE shook clear off the inside first turn, pace, stopped when headed, jogged in. FOLLOWING A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF THE RUNNER UP AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE FIRST TURN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND.

IRISH INDYGO forwardly placed along the inside into the first turn, continued to save ground in the second flight onto the backstretch, bit closer second turn, moved out for the drive, collared the leader from the outside past the furlong marker, quickly clear, geared down late to ridden out. FIERY DEBUT moved up to race in the second flight before a half on the outside, remained within striking distance the middle part, continued outside into the lane, chased the winner past the furlong marker, proved no match for that one to the wire, narrowly held the place while between horses at the wire. JOSEPH POTATO in tight at the start, raced back, continued to lack speed into the far turn, angled out five wide when advancing into the straight, angled in past the furlong marker, lodged a bid for the second spot, missed while closest to the inside of the second flight well behind the winner. BIG BOY LUKA void of early foot, continued to late far turn, steered out to be widest for the drive, rallied down the middle of the course, lugged in a bit midstretch then was straightened to finish willingly, too late for the runner up spot. TOQUE broke out to bother an outer rival, was straightened to narrowly show the way into the first turn, set a

pressured pace up the backstretch, disposed of that pursuer into the stretch, caved in when confronted the final furlong. NOBLE GEM in mid pack first turn toward the inside, continued to save some ground into and through the second bend, went evenly through the lane in lacking a serious closing bid. RIVER REVIVAL also in the main body, raced off the inside, came three wide into the stretch, slight bother a furlong out, also found lacking in the final furlong. BEAUTIFUL QUALITY vied early, fell back to race in the second flight while between rivals, checked up when lacking room behind a tiring front runner late in the second turn, fell back and did not recover. ROCKIN EMPIRE reluctant to load, lacked speed for six furlongs, picked off a couple of tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. REALLY READY rank in the early going, moved out be four wide first turn, continued outside, four wide once again in the second bend, remained back. SANFORD ROUTE with the early pace three wide, prompted the leader from the outside the middle half mile, gave way late in the second turn. DIVINING PROMISE bothered at the start to be last away, trailed throughout and was never involved.

SPIES LIKE US in mid pack while racing off the inside, patiently ridden through the second bend, two path and in some traffic entering the stretch, split foes, set down, late burst to be up in time. IT'S NANCYTIME NOW broke back, lacked speed while saving ground, continued inside through the turn and into the stretch, encountered some traffic nearing midstretch, moved out and displayed some late interest from between horses. DIVA READY lacked early foot while between horses, traffic upper stretch, finished evenly when clear the final furlong. CHITCHATCHITCHAT antsy in the gate prior to the start, broke a step slow, moved out, made a slight advance four wide through the turn then went flat through the lane. SERENE SPIRIT broke up front, showed the way up the backstretch and into the turn in the two path, continued off the inside, dueled into the lane gave way after dropping to the inside.

GOAL broke with the leaders, vied along the inside into the first turn, allowed the leaders to go onto the backstretch, continued to track into the far turn, patiently handled when covered up a bit in that bend, tipped out for the drive, engaged the pacesetter from the outside approaching the furlong grounds, put a head in front and then kicked clear under steady handling. UNLIMITED GOLD in the main group while between horses through the first turn, unhurried up the backstretch, three wide through the final bend, called on for run into the stretch and finished up willingly to earn the place. APICTURESWORTH in the

second flight while three wide, remained within striking distance far turn, idled through midstretch then made late push to regain the third spot. HOP TO IT broke back, lacked speed off the inside, came on the outside and made a late run to pick up several position while gaining for third. BINT MISCHIEF broke out, with the early pace while between horses and outside the winner, showed the way onto the backstretch, rated through some reasonable fractions, continued to hold the advantage into the stretch, yielded to the winner and then weakened to lose additional position in the final sixteenth. LIL' HOTTIE last away, continued to trail most of the way, swung out six wide turning for home, finished willingly with some belated interest. MAGGIES BREW void of any speed, came four wide out of the final turn, picked off mostly tiring rivals to improve and finish up in a busy third flight at the wire. PALACE LIGHTS well back off the pace along the inside, continued to save ground second turn, lacked closing punch. COUNTRY ECONOMICS floated out a bit at the break, was straightened and raced with the lead pack past the wire the first time, prompted the leader the middle half while to that one's outside, had little left for the drive. RIBADEO settled behind the pace along the inside, asked along second turn, no response, gave way through the stretch. CORONA PRINCESS settled in mid pack, cut the corner into the lane, weakened through the lane. DERBY EFFORT four wide when briefly forwardly placed through the first turn, began a steady retreat before a half.
