LOVELY LUCY chased the pace two wide around the turn, three deep pursuit leaving the furlong marker, drew even nearing the sixteenth pole, wore down foe kicked away to wire. INSTAGRAN GIRL sent hard out of the chute, swift solo pace around the turn, left lead inside rival through the final sixteenth, stayed on well for the place. P B FOXY shuffled back lost path through the chute, inside bid chased on willingly late. CENTIMORGAN very slow out of the chute, trailer leaving the quarter pole, bid four wide into the lane, no late kick. TALAVERA pressed off the pace to the turn, rail bid leaving the furlong marker, never factored late. BREAKING BULLET chased off the pace three wide around the turn, between rivals into the lane, weakened through the stretch. THERER WAS A JOCKEY'S OBJECTION IN THIS RACE, THE RIDER OF P B FOXY CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF INSTAGRAN GIRL FOR INTEREFERENCE THROUGH THE CHUTE, AFTER THE JUDGE'S REVIEW THE RESULT STOOD OFFICIAL NO CHANGE.

SNOWY JUBA CAT quickest leaving the chute, pace inside around the turn, inside foe battled through the final sixteenth, bumped very late, game finish in defeat. SHEWEARSSTILETTOS raced well off the pace into the turn, bid between upper, angled inside avoided fader at the sixteenth pole, chased on willingly through the wire. PRINCESS MARGARET raced off the pace four wide around the turn, bid five wide into the lane, flattened out through the final stages. COWGIRL ATTITUDE in hot pursuit three deep leaving the furlong marker, faded through the final sixteenth. TIZ THE REASON pressed inside around the turn, roused on along the rail through the lane, never fired late. LOVE OF GRACE broke through gate pre-start, very sluggish out of the chute, never factored. DON TEQUILAS shuffled back along the rail soon after the start, relaxed around the first turn, steady progress down the back side, upped the tempo five deep leaving the furlong pole, drew on even terms with CASE ACE approaching the sixteenth marker, kicked away under steady encouragement. CASE ACE displayed good early foot, dueled two deep into the far turn, shook free from inside foe leaving the quarter pole, solo lead turning into the lane, collared at the sixteenth, chased on well bested the rest.
