BACHELORETTE rated close inside, gave chase toward the three eighths pole and raced near the rail on the far turn, but flattened stride inside the eighth pole. TINA TINA TINA raced in the five path the first turn, left the turn toward the outside and gave chase nearing the three eighths pole, rounded the far turn about the six path and flattened in the lane. THE MONEY MACHINE saved ground on the first turn, gave chase into the backstretch, rounded the far turn in the five path and weakened in the lane. TURBO MILLIE saved ground racing well back, picked up the chase past the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the far turn at the rail and showed little in the lane. SWEET FACTOR raced off the rail the first turn then gave chase past the half mile pole, rounded the far turn in the four path and weakened in the lane. SISTER
