HAPPY YEARS rated the pace inside, was hand urged leaving the half mile pole then asked from the three eighths and kept the edge over Doctor Pardo from that point, widened at the rail on the far turn and was steadily handled in the lane. GRUMPY'S BUDDY raced well back toward the inside, started his bid nearing the three eighths pole, raced in the four path on the far turn and closed well to take second inside the sixteenth pole. DON'TCALLTOOEARLY ran well back from early contention in the two and three paths, picked up the chase leaving the seven sixteenths pole and improved steadily, raced in the four path on the far turn then flattened inside the sixteenth pole. STRONG LIL KOKORO settled back in the three path, gave chase leaving the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the far turn about the three path and ran evenly in the lane. DOCTOR PARDO stalked two deep then gave chase from the three eighths pole, but dropped back toward the quarter and weakened leaving the far turn. LET'S EAT rounded the first turn about the seven path then angled in past the seven eighths pole, picked up the chase leaving the seven sixteenths, raced at the rail on the far turn and weakened. MOON FALL saved ground racing well off the pace, gave chase from the seven sixteenths pole but showed little response. MALEKES MAGIC raced in the five path the first turn then sixteenths pole but weakened into the far turn. TIME TO CHOOSE rounded the first turn in the four path then stalked from the seven eighths pole, faded past the nine sixteenths, showed no response leaving the second turn and was eased from the three eighths pole.
