TITIAN lagged early, drove four wide, was carried out in the final turn, dueled outside of STREET VENDOR, and won the bob. STREET VENDOR allowed to settle early, shifted out and drifted wider on the final turn, engaged in a duel but just missed after a sustained drive. OUR SUNSHINE lacked a solid bid. GEM QUALITY stalked the pace, moved up closer entering the backstretch, and faltered into the stretch.
