FED BOY hustled from the break and seized the early advantage, rated nicely while maintaining a length or two at all times, opened up on the turn while under confident handling, and drew off under a hand ride. BOBBY DAZZLER allowed to settle from the break, raced a few lengths off the pace early, then pulled the rider to be up close going into the turn, took advantage of a clear path along the rail to move up to the second position through the turn, then chased the winner home while miles clear of the next finisher. DARK PASSENGER raced close to the pace three wide early, launched a bid from the three-furlong pole, bid three-wide into the stretch, failed to change leads, and faltered in upper stretch. BROOKLAND chased from four or five lenghts back in the early stages, continued to trail through the turn but kept to task and managed to pass one just before the wire. JUSTINFLATION was the closest pursuer to FED BOY from the start, stalked a length or two behind through the backstretch run, started to weaken after passing the three-furlong pole, and had little energy left for the stretch run.

TANGO FOR THE SOUL settled mid-pack on the rail, moved up to be a clear second approaching the three-furlong pole, chased TOURISTICA into the stretch, had trouble with the lead change but kept to task, closed the margin, and outlasted that rival in the end to prevail. TOURISTICA sprinted clear to a five or six length lead with the rider doing little to temper the pace, started to shorten strides in upper stretch, and was all-out to get to the line but was overtaken in the final yards. IT'S A GOLD AFFAIR sent hard but was unable to contest the pace, settled between horses in the tracking group down the backstretch, started a bid from the seven-sixteenths marker, was gaining ground with a mild rally up the rail in the stretch then had to check with about fifty yards to go and lost any chance. BRIAR'S ROSE was under a drive from the break but was outrun and dropped to last, kept on from far back and passed a few tired foes in the stretch. CLASSY REGARD'S raced four wide with the second flight came under a hard ride with three furlongs to run, but was unable to generate a rally. ABSOLUTE PLEASURE broke well, chased TOURISTICA from second down the backstretch, gave way passing the three-furlong pole and stopped in the stretch. CARAVALLA showed little and trailed far back throughout.

SHE'S SINGLE AGAIN rushed up the rail after a tardy start to assume command near the nine-sixteenths marker, extended the lead through the turn, responded when set down under a mild threat in upper stretch, and widened to the finish. DAZ LIN FORCE broke well but was held up off the early pace through the initial stages, moved to chase the leader through the turn, got within two lengths at the head of the stretch, but was no match while finishing well clear of the third horse. WORTHY SPIRIT got away well, tracked close up to the turn, was put into a stiff drive from the three-furlong pole, produced a griding finish under intermittent right-handed urging, and was able to gain the third spot. FLIRTATION CARD broke well and vied between horses for the early lead before being overtaken by SHE'S SINGLE AGAIN midway down the backstretch, went evenly in the stretch, and was unable to save third. SMOKIN JOY tracked in the back half of the field, then was unable to summon anything in the late stages. GO WITT GO was last away, three wide, and had to be ridden to regain contact with the field, was kept in a drive but had little to offer in the stretch. KIKIS GOLDEN TOUCH raced at the rear of the field down the backstretch, was unable to keep pace with the rest on the turn and was not involved in the later stages.

SIR BREGOVIC broke well, sent hard to the front, dueled inside of SILENT RUNNER through the early stages, put a head in front on the turn, left that rival and the rest behind at the quarter pole, was desperate for the finish line by mid-stretch and just held on under strong handling to. GEM QUALITY outpaced early, settled mid-pack, bid in earnest from the quarter pole, kept on well under steady handling, closed well, and just missed. BRODY'S PAL stalked the dueling leaders to the turn, bid three wide from the three-furlong pole, dropped over to the rail in upper stretch, and finished well but came up short at the wire. CHASE THE SUN steadied when DONTBRINGMEDOWN came over at the start, settled near the back, saved ground, then put in a good late run, was gaining rapidly on the leaders, but ran out of time. SILENT RUNNER broke inward and caused a chain reaction to rivals exiting the adjacent stalls, was still away well and dueled with SIR BREGOVIC to the turn, was floated four wide on the last bend into the stretch, failed to change leads, and was outfinished in the late stages. NORTHERN FORCE broke well under coaxing, tracked four-wide down the backstretch, came under a ride from the three-furlong pole then flattened out in the stretch. MIDNITE CHILL raced in the middle of the pack and tired midway through the stretch run. DONTBRINGMEDOWN was pinballed after the start, started well behind the rest, and lost interest.

HARD DIAMOND broke well and was inside of four contesting the early lead, took command near the three-furlong pole and went clear late on the turn, responded when roused in upper stretch and steadily increased the winning margin to the wire. DETERMINED FREEDOM raced two deep, contesting the early pace, was the only one to chase the eventual winner when that one broke away from the pack, was no match for that rival, but kept on well to take second by a clear margin to the next finisher. TIME 'N TIME AGAIN was outpaced early, then under a ride to maintain position, advanced late on the turn to gain contention, and finished up with some interest to gain a minor award. OAK BAY QUALITY broke well, was briefly close up then shuffled back to mid-pack, lost position on the turn, then ran on some in the stretch and improved a bit in the late stages. CAPE'S LEGACY tracked in mid-pack to the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, but lacked a finishing kick. SAWCHUK raced three to four wide well off the pace and lacked a finish. NOW AND ZEN void
