BARAK bumped between foes at the start, was wellback inside early, roused passing the quarter, swung out to the five path at the top of the lane, and rallied past an inner pair in the final furlong. PERDITION vied for the lead between foes in the two path, lost ground under a ride around the turn, but kept on in the two path down the stretch for place. RUMOHR REIGNS set a contested pace inside, drew away from foes while tipping out to the three path in upper stretch, but flattened around the sixteenth to be caught on both sides late, appeared to have bled, and walked off. READYTOTAPNSING tracked in the three path, angled out to the six path at the top of the stretch, but flattened. RACING RIVER bumped with an inner foe at the start, trailed in the five path and made no impact from the four path down the lane. LAHUN stalked in the four path, but lost ground around the turn, and yielded. PUDDINGONTHERITZ bumped with an outer foe at the start, pressed in the three path but gave way down the stretch.
