YOU'RE ON MUTE unhurried in the beginning, moved up on the outside around the final turn, made a bid down the home stretch and was going away at the end. AFTER THE GAME raced within striking distance, made a bid at the 3/4 pole, took the lead, couldn't match strides with the winner, but was best of others. SILVER REDESDALE pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout and proved no match for the top two. I DON'T VENMO hopped at the start, racing in the back, moved up on the outside around the second turn, made a wide gain, but was no factor. LAST SECOND LOUIE raced in the middle of the field, saved ground around the second turn, put forth an even effort and lacked a kick. CHIEF KIMOSABI lacked early speed and was never a threat. INDY CHARGE vied for the early advantage, drove clear at the 1/2 pole and was finished early. RITE ON SAM void of early speed, was never close, while finishing inside. MR RAMIREZ raced near the middle of the field and dropped back. DROBNY dueled on the front end, retreated and trailed late.
