LOOKIN AT ROSES came out at the start, pressed the pace three wide, assumed command entering the stretch, drew clear and held well while kept to task. GRAN ANDREWS pressed the pace while racing between horses, bid willingly, was outclosed and finished second best. CANDY FOR CARMEL raced in the second flight two across, closed steadily and got up late for show while no threat to the top two. TUBTIMSIAM set a pressured pace to the turn, dropped back, leveled off and was caught for third. ASCENDANCE saved ground, lacked a bid and failed to menace.
