TACIT VALUE broke out, bumped with foes on both sides, then bobbed at the start, was prompted early to press the pace in the three path, stuck her head in front midway around the turn, and drew clear while on her left lead down the lane. MEATBALLSFORARIES broke out and bumped an outer foe, tracked in the two path, swung out to the four path under a ride turning into the stretch, and finished evenly to edged out place. LET'EM HATE got pinched at the start, chased in the four path, fanned out to the seven path turning into the lane, and was one paced. ECHALE GANAS stalked in the five path but flattened on her left lead down the stretch. BACK WALL BANDIT broke in and bumped an inner foe, laid in range in the four path, angled to the rail at the top of the lane, but faded. KUAGA set the pace in the two path but yielded in the stretch. PINKY SWEAR rated in the two path but weakened. KINDA CLEVER always trailed around the two path.
