NOTTURNO pressed the pace through the first turn before settling behind between foes, made a four wide bid at the top of the stretch to surge by in the final sixteenth. KUZ IT'S CHILLY rated in the three path, advanced up the backstretch to press the pace through the turn and claim the lead at the top of the stretch, unable to hold off driving foe. AMAZING BERNIE stumbled at the start to be off the pace on the inside, loomed along the inside of the far turn to contest the lead in the stretch but was unable to close the distance. BRINDANO settled back to trail early, advanced along the outside of the far turn, angled in towards the two path to finish well. RAY'S BLUE WAGON stumbled at the start, raced off the pace between foes, weakened in the final furlong. SANDINI showed good early speed, relinquished the lead at the top of the stretch and faded. KNOCKOUT GUY rated on the inside, through after half, eased across.
