LIKE A DREAM prompted the pace to the head of the stretch, rallied well through the lane and prevailed in a determined drive. SEA SHANTY stalked the pace from the rail through the turn, cut the corner turning for home, was in tight in upper stretch, drifted in to gap, rallied up the fence and just missed in a good effort. AL GIMAAM rated along the fence saving ground to midway on the far turn, tipped out splitting rivals and closed willingly between rivals only to be denied by the top pair. CANADIAN BEAR reserved off the pace while caught wide, rallied in upper stretch to loom midway down the lane and was outfinished to miss the major awards.
