DUCK GOOSE hustled from the break to gain inside position and the lead, led the way down the backstretch while getting some pressure from STONECOLDHANDSOME to the outside with several in close pursuit, responded to a threat by MORAL POWER near the quarter pole and dug in gamely, held that rival at bay to mid-stretch, and was pulling away a bit in the end. MORAL POWER settled near the back of the pack early, circled the field four-wide on the far turn, loomed a threat to DUCK DUCK GOOSE in mid-stretch but hung. DONUT DUST raced in the middle of the pack along the rail, got caught in traffic through the far turn then ran on some once clear in the stretch to gain third. STONECOLDHANDSOME was sent from the break, settled into a stalking position behind DUCK DUCK GOOSE through the first half-mile then weakened near the quarter pole and was unable to find the needed response in the lane. PAYNTED LION got good position close up through the early stages, launched a bid after passing the seven-sixteenths marker, then steadied just past the three-furlong pole, lost momentum and struggled to recover. MORE THAN CUTE moved up after the break to race just behind the pace along the rail, came under a stiff drive mid-way on the far turn and lacked the needed response. MANOAH'S GLORY took up shortly after the start, dropped to last early, moved up to join the main pack going into the far turn, went four to five wide into the stretch but was unable to threaten. WHISKEY raced in mid-pack three-to-four wide throughout then tired in the stretch. SUGAR ON FIRE went three-wide on the first turn then pulled to race up close to the pace down the backstretch three-wide, came under a ride mid-way through the far turn, and faded. THE JOCKEY ON #8 PAYNTED LION

MYLUCKEYVALENTINE dueled two-deep through moderate fractions, was set down and gained a slight advantage mid-way on the far turn, came in to the stretch with a clear lead and held sway under steady handling and urging. PRIME MOTIVE tracked just behind the dueling leaders through the early stages, was sent to challenge for the lead with three furlongs to go, chased the winner home but won the battle for the place. KING FREUD broke well and moved up through the clubhouse turn to duel inside of MYLUCKEYVALENTINE going down the backstretch, gave way near the quarter pole but kept on well but was out finished for the third spot. LUCKY LUCKY LUCKY LUCKY here-to-four wide through the early stages, launched a mild bid on the far turn then went a little flat in the stretch and could not threaten. CLOUD FOREST was always prominent to the inside through the first half-mile, came under a drive after passing the three-furlong pole, then went one-paced in the late stages. VALORE raced about three-wide forward in the main pack, then lacked a

kick in the stretch, finishing evenly. BLACKWATER FALLS raced near the back of the main pack and never fired. LONG ASTRIDE got over to the two-pack on the first turn, had good position going down the backstretch, then weakened on the far turn and was not a factor in the late stages. PURE REALIZATION was forwardly placed with the main pack for a half-mile, then came under a ride and struggled to keep up in the latter stages. SUPREME BEING lacked any early speed, raced well behind the main pack and never threatened. THE COLORA KID dwelt at the start and broke well behind the rest, trailed far back and was never a factor.

VICTORY HALL broke well but backed off a potential speed duel, tracked close behind the pace battle, bid three-wide into the stretch then shifted out a path to get around a tiring PROJECT MAXIMUS, then finished up strongly under steady handling to win clear. DOWNANDDIRTYDONNA settled mid-pack through the early stages, was still left with much to do at the top of the stretch, dove to the rail in upper stretch and was kept to task under steady urging to get up for the place in the shadow of the wire. PROJECT MAXIMUS raced three-wide in the early pace battle, always traveling well, put a head in front passing the quarter pole, started to shorten strides while racing on the wrong lead in mid-stretch, held on grimly but was overtaken in the final yards. NEON SUNSET settled three-wide near the back, launched a bid on the turn, altered course in upper stretch to avoid the stricken rival, had some trouble changing leads but finished up will to just miss out on a minor award. LAW SCHOOL sent hard for the lead from the break, had the inside position in the three-way contest for the early lead, came under a stiff drive on the turn and faltered in the stretch. CAPOS SUGAR KANE vied for the lead between horses to the stretch then gave way. SOLEIL VOLANT settled mid-pack on the rail in cover through the early stages, then tipped out a path to start a forward move midway on the turn to press for the lead at the top of the stretch, chased a stubborn rival in THUNDERING for the length of the stretch gradually closed the margin in the final yards and got up in the last jump. THUNDERING stalked the lone pacesetter two-deep in-hand, inherited the lead late on the far turn, then responded nicely when set down at the top of the stretch, went a length clear and finished up well under strong handling, dug in gamely when confronted by SOLEIL VOLANT late and just failed to last in a solid effort. VERSUS settled inside near the back, started to run on heading into the far turn, tipped out to the three-path late going into the last bend, finished up strong, could not get to the top pair but finished clear of the next horse. GEOMETRY was a bit keen through the initial stages, pulled to be up close going down the backstretch, became boxed in late on the far turn, then finished up well when clear, but was not quite good enough. OHIO JOE lacked early speed, kept to the inside to the stretch then was kept to task and passed a few tirred rivals. SNOOKIE BEAR tracked three-wide near the rear of the main group, came under a ride midway on the turn, but was unable to threaten. HOPE'S ALIVE pushed for forward position, then went to a clear lead with the rider trying to temper the pace, was overtaken near the quarter pole and had nothing left for the stretch run. KING OF ASHES raced three-wide through the early stages, then retreated on the far turn and was uninvolved in the late stages. FLASH FROZEN refused to break at the start, was unloaded and walked off.

SWEET WINE hustled away from the gate, went three-wide through the first turn with two rivals to the inside, then backed off a bit down the backstretch, re-engaged with SEVEN'S MAGIC midway through the far turn, left that rival behind when set down in upper stretch and drew away late. SEVEN'S MAGIC was sent to the front from the break, vied between horses through the early stages, then took command midway on the far turn only to be challenged by SWEET WINE, could not go on with that one in upper stretch but kept on well to save the place. VAMONOS CHICAS got away well, settled in mid-pack three-wide, followed SWEET WINE late on the far turn into the stretch, was out kicked by that rival but kept on well to out-finish the rest for the third prize. MADDIE'S NOTION raced four-wide well off the early pace, then ran on some through the late stages and just missed a minor award. GORTREAGH GAL was not asked for speed from the break, settled at the back of the main pack through the early stages, took up before the five-sixteenths marker, then re-bid

three to four wide into the stretch and made up some ground in the late stages while never a serious threat. BIG BOLT was off slow, moved up late on the first turn and early on the backstretch run to be up near the near the leaders heading in to the far turn, became boxed in through that turn, then lacked the needed response once clear in the stretch. FLEETING MEMORY was off a step slow, moved up through the first turn to race behind the leaders down the backstretch, steadied near the five-sixteenths marker and was unable to recover momentum. XOCHIL was the inside horse in the early speed battle, maintained position to the far turn, then gave way readily just past the three-furlong pole. DENIM N LACE was acting up and reared as the gates opened, still being held by the outrider, spotted the field a massive head start but kept on and finished the race, beating one rival to the line. MADISON COUNTY broke well, raced mid-pack through the initial stages, then started to lose contact with the field after passing the five-furlong pole, dropped far behind and was not persevered with from that point. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE START. AFTER A REVIEW IT WAS DETERMINED THAT #6 DENIM N LACE WAS NOT GIVEN A FAIR START AND DECLARED A NON-STARTER.
