READY TO POUNCE stalked up close in the three path, followe the top pair to the far turn, bid three deep midway around the bend, kicked clear in upper stretch and held well over the late run from the runner-up. TRUSTY RUSTY raced off the rail near the back early on, gained while angling six wide on the second bend, finished well through the lane but could not get by. MONGOLIAN MAX dueled from inside around the clubhouse turn, dropped back a bit to give chase in the middle stages, saved ground through the far turn, tipped two wide into the lane and held third over FIREMAN DAN late. FIREMAN DAN chased in the two path, moved out on the backstretch, rounded the far turn four then five wide, tried to split foes but lacked room briefly midstretch, kept on after gaining a clear path but could not get up for third. ZIMBA WARRIOR sat off the pace in the two path then moved inside, tipped out leaving the far turn, chased between rivals midstretch and improved position. MAN CHILD raced up close four then three wide early, had the left-rein break early on the backstretch, went up to challenge for the lead on the outside, led between rivals with a quarter mile left to run, yielded to the winner at the top of the lane and weakened. JOINT VENTURE tracked five then four wide around the first turn, stayed off the rail up the backstretch, spun four wide into the lane and flattened out. LEYAS CANDY dueled from outside around the first turn, moved inside fighting with an outer rival on the backstretch, vied with outer pair late

on the far turn, yielded entering the lane and weakened in the drive. ATTILA THE DUN trailed from inside then moved off the rail, continued at the back three to four wide on the far turn and was never a factor.

MR. LEASURE stalked from inside then pulled between rivals on the first turn, moved back inside, stalked the top pair to the quarter pole, given his cue shortly after, chased within striking distance into deep stretch, dug in between rivals and took over approaching the wire while outkicking NIGHT OUT in the final strides. NIGHT OUT settled in the two path, moved out three deep in the middle stages, coaxed along into the far turn, fell back to last still three wide on the second bend, had one beat while tipping out into the lane, closed gamely four deep late but was outkicked by the winner. PACIFIC QUEST pressed from inside in hand then dueled on the backstretch, fought head to head through the far turn, cleared in upper stretch and got run down approaching the wire. BLAMETHEGOODTIMES had to steady when losing a clear path nearing the clubhouse turn, traveled along the inside at the back, drew closer on the far turn, ran into some traffic entering the lane, rallied from inside and missed third. SPRINT OUT PASS traveled two wide at the back, raced between rivals into the second bend, got boxed in from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, continued two wide into the lane, angled out and improved position. BACKDOOR ROYALTY sat off the apce on the inside, moved into range between rivals, came under a ride still between on the second bend, brushed with LET SEAMUS GO leaving the far turn and weakened in the drive. LET SEAMUS GO raced up close in the two then three path, chased three deep around the far turn, brushed with inner rival coming to the lane and weakened. TARGARYIS took a short lead outside a rival early, dueled up the backstretch and far turn, fought to the three-sixteenths pole and folded.

LEFT HAND MAN chased four then three deep early, crept closer in the three path on the turn, challenged from outside in upper stretch, dueled with ZOMBO BOMBO through the final furlong and edged the runner-up. ZOMBO BOMBO drifted in and brushed early, vied three deep up the backstretch, dueled outside a rival through the turn, put away inner competitor in upper stretch while meeting the bid from LEFT HAND MAN, fought head to head down the lane but came up just short. INVINCIBLE got bumped early, showed speed between rivals then chased after the leaders to the turn, followed in the two path around the bend, steered out with a furlong remaining but lacked the needed late kick. CUPID'S CRUSADER broke a step slow, moved inside racing at the back, angled out and came three to four wide into the stretch and earned a minor award. JARAMA got knocked into inner rival leaving the gate, bumped again early, vied inside a pair of rivals in the opening stages, dueled around the turn, yielded in upper stretch and weakened. WESTERN AVENUE showed good early foot from inside, brushed with outer rival and started to climb a bit, lost ground on the turn, shifted over to the two path around the bend and weakened. NIJINSKY HALO got bumped leaving the gate, knocked into inner rival early and steadied, dropped back on the turn, moved out in the lane and could not threaten. TOUGHNESS broke in and bumped, vied between rivals holding a short advantage in the early going, yielded to the top pair at the five-sixteenths pole, moved to the inside and tired down the lane.

TEJON PASS dueled from inside up the backstretch and around the turn, inched ahead midstretch and held over BAD UNCLE BARRY in the final strides. BAD UNCLE BARRY stalked the top pair outside a rival, ridden along two wide into the lane, moved out in the upper stretch, drew alongside the top pair in deep stretch and could not get by the winner. VANCOUGAR was forced to check early, jumped a shadow near the half-mile pole, saved ground to the

stretch and got up for third. ITZEL fought outside TEJON PASS for command, battled head to head to the eighth pole, yielded to the top pair in deep stretch and lost third near the wire. THE RABBI unhurried in the opening stages, angled in to save ground around the bend, moved off the fence in the drive and showed a mild late rally. ANMER HALL got squeezed between rivals early, raced off the pace outside a rival, drew closer between around the turn, moved out in the drive and kept trying despite failing to threaten. BETTERDAYSRCOMING (IRE) stalked the top pair inside a rival, continued along the fence around the bend, came off the rail in the lane but lacked further response. YACOWLEF (IRE) traveled outside a rival at the rear early, had one beat while in the two path turning for home and could not make an impact. VASA stalked three deep early, went three then four wide around the bend, rallied from outside and nailed CORNHUSKERCHRIS on the line. CORNHUSKERCHRIS pressed the pace from outside, lost touch with the leader but remained close two to three wide around the turn, came back to challenge midstretch, put a head in front inside the sixteenth pole, led into the final moments and got nailed at the wire. MODUS BESTIA stepped to the front and set the pace under pressure from outer rival, cleared around the bend, showed the way into the final furlong, challenged again by CORNHUSKERCHRIS midstretch and was outfinished by the top pair in the last sixteenth. GENIUS JIMMY stepped to the front and moved inside, took pressure at the seven-sixteenths pole, put that rival away at the quarter pole, led a bit off the rail into the lane and remained clear under urging. SIENNOIS (IRE) settled inside, continued to save ground through the far turn, tipped out at the top of the lane, finished determinedly down the lane to gain second but could not reach the winner. POKERKNIGHTATVEES chased after the pacesetter three deep, went four wide into the turn, exited the bend in the two path, closed in slowly but steadily down the stretch, drew alongside the runner-up late and got up near the wire. TITANIC THOMPSON bobbled a bit leaving the gate then sped clear, padded the lead on the turn, asked left handed inside the eighth pole, remained clear into deep stretch, came under threat from the winner late and got nailed at the wire. MINISTER SHANE chased inside a pair of rivals from the two path into the turn, moved over to the rail around the bend, stayed within range down the lane but could only hold third while gaining minor ground late. LETMEIN climbed in the early going, got floated out at the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch and showed late effort for a minor award. RUNKERRY sat off the pace along the inside, moved out to the two path around the bend and lacked further response in the drive. THE G M tracked out of range off the rail, lugged out at the five-sixteenths pole, angled back down to the two path and improved position. NO MORE DING DONGS raced near the back in the early going, checked past the three-eighths pole, angled to the inside, steered back out into the lane and failed to menace. PASS THE BATON lacked early speed and disliked the kickback, angled to the rail on the turn and failed to menace. PANUCO dropped off the pace early, went three deep into the turn, got forced out at the five-sixteenths pole, chased four wide into the lane and was never

a factor. MR. MACHUPICCHU chased the lone speed between rivals, dropped back on the turn, came three wide into the lane and tired.

RIBBONS stepped to the front in the two path then crossed to the inside, set all the pace to the stretch, took pressure from NAFISA outside the sixteenth pole but turned that rival away and finished strong to the wire. AMERICAN PRIVILEGE tucked inside off the pace, crept closer on the far turn, entered the

lane in the two path, angled back to the inside, steered out midstretch, came with a late run but ran out of ground. NAFISA stalked along the inside, drew closer around the second bend, moved out in upper stretch, put in a bid midstretch but was turned away by the winner. FOR ARROGATE traveled outside a rival near the back, angled out on the far turn, spun five wide into the lane, put in a mild rally and rounded out the superfecta. MISS ARTOIS broke out and bumped, settled four deep then angled into the three path, had to steady off heels while getting bumped around the bend, traveled outside a pair of rivals in the middle stages, stayed off the rail to the stretch, moved further out in the lane and improved position. TOES traveled in mid-pack on the inside, gained between on the far turn, entered the lane three deep but flattened in the stretch. CHURCH LADY (IRE) broke a step slow and bumped, trailed along the inside, saved ground around the far turn, tipped out in upper stretch and lacked a rally. LADY CHIC was rank chasing two wide on the clubhouse turn, asked while angling out to the four path around the far turn and weakened in the drive. UNBINDING (GB) raced up close inside the leader then moved outside, followed in the two path on the far turn, then faded in the stretch run. GLADLY traveled three then two wide around the clubhouse turn, exited the backstretch three deep, angled inward and passed tired rivals. THEA pulled and shifted out to bump outer rival on the first turn, chased between rivals off the pace into the far turn, continued two wide into the lane and had little left for the drive. AUNTIE bumped leaving the gate, became rank chasing three wide on the clubhouse turn, rounded the far turn three, four, then five wide and weakened.
