PROUD STARLET broke in and bumped, stepped to the front and moved inside, maintained a clear lead into deep stretch and held safely. COMEBACK GIRL stalked the lone leader along the inside, tipped two wide past the quarter pole, chased determinedly through the lane but had to settle for second best. TIGHT SQUEEZE bumped leaving the gate, traveled on the inside near the back, entered the lane two wide, moved out in upper stretch and gained third. ALMENDARES (GB) unhurried in the two path, crept closer under a hold on the far turn, found traffic entering the lane, angled between rivals in upper stretch, surged to the front midstretch and drove clear. ZIO JO followed in range on the inside, continued to save ground through the far turn, lacked room behind the leaders in upper stretch, bid between once gaining a clear path and earned the place honors. NINEELEVENTURBO got bumped on both sides early, tucked inside at the rear, moved off the fence and passed a pair of rivals on the backstretch, went two wide into the far turn, angled four wide around the bend, steered out widest in the stretch and rallied for third. FINAL BOSS took control early and set the tone from inside, got pressured from outside with three furlongs remaining, resisted into the final furlong, lost command midstretch and yielded in the last sixteenth. ASTRONOMER stalked the speed from the two path, roused on the far turn, tipped out at the top of the lane to launch a bid but lacked the needed late punch. BRAN (FR) sat off the pace in the two

path, moved into range two then three wide on the second bend, moved out and bid with a furlong left to run but was outkicked in the late stages. ENDLESSLY steered to the inside racing towards the back of the pack, trailed up the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn as well, moved out in the lane and showed late interest but never got involved. THIRSTY REBEL showed early speed inside a pair of rivals then ceded command, went two then three wide in pursuit on the turn, challenged from outside at the top of the lane, cleared with a furlong remaining and drew off. THOUGHT PROCESS stalked from inside into the first turn, was keen to go on around the bend, split foes and went up to press the leader into the backstretch, backed off to stalk again in the middle stages, applied pressure again at the three-eighths pole, took the lead with a quarter mile remaining, kicked clear in upper stretch, drifted out but held comfortably under a tap of right handed urging and flagging from the crop in the last sixteenth. CASALU tracked inside to two wide on the clubhouse turn, drew closer between rivals into the far turn, took aim three wide turning for home, moved out chasing determinedly in the second but could never reach the winner. WILL THEN allowed to settle near the back on the inside, remained on the fence to the stretch, move into striking distance in upper stretch, lacked the needed late punch but was able to earn the show honors. INDISPENSABLE sat off the pace four then three wide early, moved up four deep into the backstretch, bid four then three wide on the far turn, put in a head in front in upper stretch, drifted out and exchanged bumps with LYELL'S SONG in the furlong grounds, dug in late and edged the runner-up. LYELL'S SONG settled early in the three path, tracked outside a pair of rivals in the middle stages, gained three then four wide on the far turn, challenged three deep in upper stretch, put in a head in front past the eighth pole, drifted in and exchanged bumps with INDISPENSABLE and got outkicked in the end. BRAZENLY settled five wide in the early going, moved closer up the backstretch, ridden along while keep wide through the far turn, entered the lane six wide, took aim at the top trio down the lane but flattened in the last sixteenth. VARNEY sent for the lead, pressured into the backstretch, headed at the quarter pole, lost command in upper stretch, fought to midstretch and weakened. BETTER THAN GOLD tucked inside at the rear, moved off the rail on the backstretch, rounded the far turn three then four wide and passed tired rivals. TRANCHE stalked three wide early, bid three deep between on the second bend, failed to sustain the challenge at the quarter pole, angled in a bit leaving the bend and weakened. CONCORD BRIDGE forwardly placed in the two path, moved up to apply pressure under a hold, weakened on the far turn and tired down the lane. TIZ SECURE stalked from inside, ridden along leaving the backstretch,

HANNAH BUCKLE (IRE) stalked from inside, tipped out and bid between in upper stretch, then drove clear in the last sixteenth. QUICK BROWN FOX was

closest in pursuit from the two path, applied pressure from outside in the middle stages, battled three deep into the final furlong and got outkicked by the winner. DEFIANCE content to trail early and steered to the inside, came off the rail on the far turn and exited the bend in the three path, angled out for a clear run in the lane, flew late and gained third. MOTET stepped to the front and moved inside, took pressure on the backstretch, maintained a short lead to the top of the stretch, fought inside a pair of rivals at the eighth pole, lost command midstretch and weakened late. GRECIAN GODDESS reserved on the inside, roused around the far turn still next to the fence, tipped out at the top of the lane and finished evenly late. LADY OF POWER rated outside a pair of rivals, angled out on the far turn, entered the lane in the five path, kept trying down the stretch but needed to find more. SHE'S A JOKER raced in range from the two path between rivals around both turns, moved out in the lane and lacked a rally. ROSELEE MAY stalked three wide around the first turn, stayed off the rail to the second bend, spun four wide into the stretch and weakened.
