SKYQUIST trailed three wide early, picked up stride still traveling off the rail on the far turn, angled out a bit past the eighth pole, rallied between runners and got up late. JENNYS TIZ settled four then three wide early, chased in range staying wide up the backstretch, rounded the far turn in the five then four path, rallied widest in the drive, fought on even terms into the last sixteenth and got outclosed by the winner. TAPIT DYNASTY raced up close in the three path, challenged between rivals in the middle stages, dueled from outside around the far turn, put a head in front in upper stretch, clung to a narrow lead with a sixteenth remaining and got outfinished by the top pair. CANO FOR THE WIN stalked five wide around the first turn, vied four deep up the backstretch, four then three deep on the second bend, fought to upper stretch, was outfinished in the furlongs grounds but remained close to the wire. RASTAMAN VIBE stalked along the inside in hand, followed behind the leader to the top of the stretch, tipped out and launched a bid in upper stretch, took over midstretch and drove clear. TIME SONG stepped to the front and moved inside, set all the pace to the stretch, asked right handed while taking pressure from RASTAMAN VIBE in upper stretch, drifted out past the eighth pole, lost command shortly after and held second. SPYCATCHER was a bit rank in the early going when reserved on the inside, angled out on the final turn and chased five wide into the lane, rallied into contention but lacked the needed late punch in deep stretch. ZALAMO (FR) tracked the pace from inside, tipped out at the quarter pole, came three wide into the lane, chased between rivals in upper stretch, angled inward in the final furlong and finished willingly. RODRIGOKNOWS sat off the pace in the two path, moved inside first time in the stretch, crept closer still saving ground on the third turn, kept on trying down the lane but needed to find more. PRIVMAN stepped to the front and showed the way with PENALTY BOX applying pressure to the outside, maintained a short lead up the backstretch and far turn, started to shake free from PENALTY BOX in upper stretch but ducked in from right handed urging, straightened course quickly and drew away under hand urging and flagging from the crop. PENALTY BOX pressed PRIVMAN from outside, hounded the winner to midstretch but proved no match in the last sixteenth while clearly second best. RANK hustled from the gate, chased from inside, drifted out and bumped on the first turn, entered the far turn in the two path, angled four wide around the bend and bested the rest. FAUSTO was antsy in the gate, trailed off the rail around the first turn, traveled outside a rival on the backstretch, angled to the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. CHEEVER stalked from inside, lost ground while moving off the fence on the far turn and weakened down the lane. PRAYER got bumped chasing three wide on the first turn, ridden along up the backstretch, lost ground three then four wide on the second bend and came up empty in the drive. UNIQUE POWER stalked the top pair in the two path, tired around the far turn, came three wide into the lane and had little left for the stretch run.

VELOCITY tracked from inside, dropped off the pace on the backstretch, drew closer on the far turn, angled out in the lane, rallied between runners and won the bob on the line. PRINCESS EM TOO raced in range from the two path, moved out and bid three deep in the final furlong, took over late and lost the bob at the wire. SLICK (IRE) traveled three deep near the back, three then two wide on the first turn, between foes on the backstretch, moved out under left handed urging in the lane, rallied five deep in the last sixteenth and got outclosed. ATIA stalked in the two path, pressed from outside early on the backstretch, cleared past the half-mile pole, dueled from inside on the far turn, resisted into the last sixteenth and yielded late. MEDORO was a bit rank when tracking in hand from the two path early and on the backstretch, drew closer around the far turn, tipped three wide into the lane, bid outside the top pair at the eighth pole, took over midstretch and drove clear. GRAND SLAM SMILE set the pace from inside, took pressure on the far turn, resisted into the final furlong, relinquished the lead to MEDORO midstretch and stayed on to secure second. LUNAR IMPACT (GB) was closest in pursuit from the two path, challenged GRAND SLAM SMILE around the far turn, fought between rivals in midstretch, could not summon the needed late kick

and saved third. VENGANZA sat off the pace on the inside, crept closer in the middle stages, was patiently handled continuing to save ground on the far turn, roused and moved off the fence at the top of the stretch, finished willingly between foes late and got up for a minor award. ALPHA BELLA raced in mid-pack between foes early, went two wide into the far turn, angled out and entered the lane in the five path, kept trying through the final furlong but got edged for a minor placing. QUEEN MAXIMA stalked the pacesetter from inside, followed patiently behind the leader around the far turn, roused in upper stretch, lacked room inside GRAND SLAM SMILE midstretch, gained a clear path in deep stretch but was too late. RAW ABILITY (IRE) saved ground towards the rear, hugged the rail to the stretch, moved out in the lane but ran into traffic at the sixteenth pole, moved inward and could not regain momentum. SUNSET GLORY (IRE) chased from off the pace three deep, moved into range in the middle stages, came under a ride three wide on the far turn, chased four deep in upper stretch and flattened out in the furlong grounds. NADETTE (FR) trailed from inside in the opening stages, traveled two wide into the second bend, steered out into the lane and failed to menace. OMNIPONTET (BRZ) got squeezed between rivals early, angled over to the rail after, coaxed along the inside then two wide on the far turn, moved out in the stretch and lacked further response. QUATRO Y VINTE (URU) raced two wide well off the pace early, stayed off the rail to the stretch and never made an impact.

SEE THROUGH IT bumped leaving the gate, stalked between rivals, asked two, three, then four wide on the turn, bid three deep in upper stretch, put a head in front at the eighth pole and maintained a short lead over FOR ALL MANKIND to the line. FOR ALL MANKIND stalked the top pair inside a pair of rivals, was ridden along while easing off the rail, bid between rivals with a furlong remaining and got outkicked by the winner. JERRY'S SPIRIT dueled from outside, cleared past the five-sixteenths pole, led two wide into the lane, challenged by a pair of rivals in upper stretch, lost command at the eighth pole and flattened in deep stretch. MANITOWISH trailed under coaxing, went two wide into the turn, spun four wide into the lane and passed tired rivals. DON'T SWEAR DAVE tracked from inside out of range, moved into striking distance on the backstretch, was ridden along leaving the far turn, moved out and bumped in upper stretch, challenged with a furlong remaining, dueled inside PROMISSIO late and gamely prevailed. PROMISSIO broke in and bumped, traveled between rivals in the two path off the pace, gained three then four wide on the far turn, brushed in upper stretch, dueled outside DON'T SWEAR DAVE late and lost a narrow photo. HURRICANE CLOUD (GB) bumped leaving the gate, raced two wide towards the back, three deep on the backstretch, spun five wide into the lane, rallied to within striking distance and took aim at the top pair but finished evenly late. SBAGLIATO raced off the pace on the inside, crept closer on the backstretch, stayed on the fence around the far turn, moved out and ran into some traffic midstretch, then found a clear path and kept on to round out the superfecta. KERRY GOLD saved ground well off the pace, cut the corner into the lane, also ran into brief traffic midstretch and kept trying once in the clear. MEGAYACHT raced on the inside near the back, rounded the far turn in the two path, angled out for a clear run and summoned a mild rally.
