SMART CODE stepped to the front and opened up a comfortable lead on the inside, remained well into the lane, led clear under left handed urging into deep stretch, grew a bit weary late but was able to hold. HEART HEADED sat off the pace in the two path, ridden along three deep at the quarter pole, moved into second with a furlong remaining, closed in on the leader in deep stretch but was too late. ONE OF THESE DAYS (IRE) saved ground from off the pace, came under a ride on the far turn, got boxed in from the three-sixteenth pole to the eighth pole, moved into the clear and finished well to edge CAISSON for the show honors. CAISSON was reserved in the opening stages on the inside, saved ground through the far turn as well, angled out at the top of the lane, rallied and missed third. BEEF WINSLOW got crowded shortly after the start, moved to the inside trailing the field, tipped out on the far turn, went three deep into the lane, moved out further and could not make an impact. MY KAT sprinted clear and crossed over, opened up around the turn, cornered nicely into the lane and widened under a few taps of right handed urging and was ridden out to the wire. THAT AIN'T RIGHT allowed to settle on the inside, tipped two to three wide on the turn, moved out further in the lane and got up for second. PRISCILLA was closest in pursuit in the early going, chased two wide around the bend, could not rally down the lane and lost second. CHICA TIGRE chased along the inside, fell out of range on the turn and weakened in the stretch run. SHEER LIGHTNING chased in range briefly then raced between rivals at the back into the turn, went two to three wide on the turn and improved position. TINA'S PRINCESS chased three deep in the early going, lost ground around the bend, came four wide into the stretch and faded. OM N JOY settled off the pace in the opening stages, closed in under urging from the two path around the turn, surged clear in upper stretch, then drew off when asked right handed midstretch and was in hand approaching the wire. HOT GIRL WALK dropped off the pace early, went two wide into the turn, advanced while angling out around the bend, spun five wide into the lane, rallied into inside the eighth pole but was no match for the winner. LADY MENDELSSOHN followed in range off the rail then three deep between rivals into the turn, asked three wide around the bend, altered out a bit at the top of the lane and earned the show honors. IN THE AIR TONIGHT traveled near the back in the early going and steered to the inside, tipped three wide on the turn before returning to the inside, moved out again in upper stretch and got outkicked for third. GOING DEEP forwardly placed from inside, tipped two then three wide on the turn under asking and weakened in the drive. FIBONACCIS RIDE chased from off the pace fur wide leaving the backstretch, angled in past the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. COOLING OFF trailed along the inside into the turn, tipped two wide at the guarter

pole, angled five wide into the lane and passed tired rivals. ELLEN JORTH stalked outside a rival then four deep to the turn, remained wide to the stretch and faded down the lane. DRINK THIS CUP stalked the lone leader outside a rival, got crowded between runners and steadied at the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back after and had little left for the drive.

BE PUNCTUAL took control in the two path, set a pressured pace up the backstretch, vied inside a pair of rivals on the far turn, dueled past the

five-sixteenths pole, drifted out in upper stretch, cleared midstretch and held over the late run from UPSTAR YANKEE in the end. UPSTART YANKEE stalked three then two wide on the first turn, moved inside on the backstretch, launched a rail bid at the five-sixteenths but was unable to keep up with the top pair with a quarter mile remaining, chased from inside into the lane, came back on in deep stretch but could not get by the winner. MOTHER'S PRAYER stalked five deep into the first turn then moved in a bit, raced up close in hand three deep in the middle stages, fought for the lead three deep into the far turn, dueled from outside past the five-sixteenths pole, got floated out by the winner in upper stretch and stayed on to hold third. SAQEEL sat off the pace on the inside, gained between into the far turn, spun four wide into the lane, angled out and finished willingly but could not get by MOTHER'S PRAYER for the show honors. DEVILNTHEBLUEGRAS got crowded between rivals early, tucked inside at the back, picked up stride in the middle stages, was ridden along at the five-sixteenths pole, spun three wide into the lane and finished evenly late. OOBUBBAKAKAYO chased six deep into the clubhouse turn, moved in a few paths around the bend, traveled three deep leaving the backstretch, got floated six wide late on the far turn and churned on down the lane while unable to threaten. ROGUE SON raced four, three, then two wide at the back around the first turn, trailed up the backstretch, asked two wide on the second bend, steered out in the lane and also failed to threaten. SUGAR BEETS sat off the pace two then three wide early, moved out and chased four deep on the backstretch, was ridden along four, three, then four wide again on the second bend, moved out further in the lane and failed to menace. HOWDOYALIKEMENOW raced up close four then three wide, applied pressure on the backstretch, vied between rivals into the far turn, could not keep up with the leaders at the five-sixteenths pole, got carried wide past the quarte
